Subject: Native American Cultural Program

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Review and approve the Youth Commission cultural program that supports public education and awareness of the Chumash people and their cultural heritage.

DISCUSSION: The Chumash Native Americans are believed to be the first inhabitants of the Santa Monica Mountains and Channel Islands region. The word “Malibu” is a combination of the Native American words “mali + wu”, which means “where the mountains meet the sea”, and the Chumash word “Humaliwo”, which means “where the surf sounds loudly.”¹

At the January 8, 2026, Special meeting, the Commission voted to assist at the 25th Annual Chumash Day Native American Powwow and Intertribal Gathering on Saturday, March 28, 2026, and Sunday, March 29, 2026, at Malibu Bluffs Park. The Commission would host a children’s activity booth or art activity.

Commissioners are asked to review and approve details for the cultural program, which may include hosting a Youth Commission children’s coloring activity or assisting with the Malibu Art Commission community mural. Volunteer times are 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM, 12:00 PM to 2:00 PM, and 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM.
