Attached are the year-to-date statistics for Malibu through September 2025.

### Noteworthy incidents

- A DUI arrest occurred on PCH/Malibu Canyon and PCH/Heathercliff.
- A transient was arrested for attempting to assault another transient with a bottle in Legacy Park.
- A vehicle was stolen from the 31000 block of PCH.
- An assault "likely to produce great bodily injury" arrest occurred on Murphy Way.
- A suspect was arrested for assault with a deadly weapon (firearm) in the 33000 block of PCH.
- Deputies conducted a traffic stop near Heathercliff Road/PCH and located an illegal firearm inside the vehicle.
- A suspect was arrested for robbery after she stole clothing at Fred Segal.
- A suspect was arrested for robbery, assault with a deadly weapon, and kidnapping after a business dispute on Civic Center Way.
- Deputies made an indecent exposure arrest in the 22000 block of PCH.
