- Collaborated with the new Deputy District Attorney at Sylmar Court to improve efficiency in case filings with the District Attorney's office.
- Participated in quarterly firearm qualification in accordance with Department policy.
- Met with Captain Carr to review unit's investigations and discuss current juvenile-related issues in the city.
- Conducted referrals related to encounter with uniformed personnel.
- Patrolled juvenile problem areas during weekend evening and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.
- Ensured record sealing procedures were initiated for subjects who completed CHAMPS diversion for minor offenses.
- Conducted 290 residential verifications for sex registrants.
