Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Agoura Meadows and Twin Oaks shopping centers several times this week.

OC canvassed I-Hop shopping center several times this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd, Kanan Rd, Reyes Adobe Rd and Canwood St. several times this week. No new contacts.

The city located an encampment believed to belong to A61 on private property. PEH breaks down his tent early in the AM. Info being forwarded to LHSD. PEH remains service resistant.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Old Town several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Calabasas Rd, Parkway Calabasas, and Park Granada several times this week.

OC canvassed Creekside Village several times this week and checked under the Agoura St. Bridge.

OC was informed that a PEH was camping behind the dumpster at McDonalds. OC engaged new contact: Female, 30s. PEH stated that she is waiting for an Uber and is leaving the area. PEH was not at the location later in the day.

OC engaged new contact at Calabasas Rd. Male, 50s. PEH was sleeping on the sidewalk. PEH did not accept a list of services stated that he was traveling through town. OC to follow up.

OC engaged new contact at Civic Center. Male, 30s. IND stated that he was not experiencing homelessness but did accept a list of services. IND has been seen bathing in the City Hall restrooms. OC to follow up.

OC was contacted by SD De Matteo regarding a local family that is getting evicted on 2/1. OC connected C73 to the Rotary Club to apply for an emergency grant. C73 is going to move in with family in LA and will continue reaching out to service providers. C73 qualified for emergency grant funds through the Rotary Club.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Central Malibu and engaged new contact. Male, 30s. PEH stated that he arrived in the area last week and has already engaged with TPC Outreach. PEH was referred to St. Josephs who can assist in replacing his documents. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Trancas Country Market. M137 continues to sleep at the bus stop.

OC canvassed Zuma Beach board walk. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Heathercliff. No new contacts.

OC was informed of a possible encampment located on the beach underneath NoBu. OC and SD Espinoza canvassed the area and did not locate any encampment. One PEH was sitting in the sand and would not engage with OC. OC updated Luis F, Public Safety Liaison.

OC informed SD Espinoza of a small encampment on private property at PCH and Cross Creek. The area was cleared. M138 and M139 are interested in shelter and continue to engage with TPC Outreach.

OC engaged M137 on Thursday at the Trancas bus stop. PEH did not know what day it was and believes she is going to meet someone who will give her the keys to a condo she bought locally. OC suggested she work with TPC and accept shelter while she waits instead of continuing to sleep outside. OC updated Luis F, Public Safety Liaison and TPC Outreach.
