

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

February 9-13

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Agoura Meadows and Twin Oaks shopping centers several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed I-Hop shopping center several times this week.

OC was informed that a possible PEH was loitering on the property near I-Hop and was asked to leave by management. OC has engaged IND in the past who denies experiencing homelessness and stays in local hotels. IND stated that her rental will be ready in March.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd, Kanan Rd, Reyes Adobe Re and Canwood St. several times this week.

OC and JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison engaged A61 at Trader Joes and informed PEH that he cannot panhandle on the property. PEH remains service resistant.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Old Town several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Calabasas Rd, Parkway Calabasas, and Park Granada several times this week.

OC canvassed Creekside Village several times this week and checked under the Agoura St. Bridge.

OC engaged new contact: Male, 50s. OC woke up PEH who was sleeping at the bus stop at Agoura Rd. and Las Virgenes. PEH did not speak English and accepted a list of resources.

OC engaged C70 at Creekside Village. OC continues to offer shelter to PEH who is dwelling in his vehicle. PEH is currently looking for work and is service resistant.

OC engaged C74 at Creekside Village. PEH continues to dwell in his vehicle and is working. OC continues to encourage PEH to sign up for services and look into temporary rental assistance as C74 gets ready to transition into an apt. PEH concerned that he makes too much money. OC assured PEH that it cant hurt to speak to a Case Manager at a service provider. OC to follow up.

Hidden Hills:

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. several times this week. No new contacts.

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. Nothing new to report.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Central Malibu. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Trancas Country Market.

TPC requested that OC contact M137 at Trancas early in the morning to see if she will stay in the area to speak to Outreach. OC made contact at 6:30am and spoke to PEH. OC was informed that TPC Outreach was able to make contact later in the afternoon.

OC canvassed Zuma Beach board walk. No new encampments or PEH were located.

OC canvassed Heathercliff. No new contacts.

OC was informed that a long time PEH experienced an emergency health issue recently and is interested in speaking to TPC Outreach. M141 has been service resistant until now. OC, SD Espinoza and Luis F, Public Safety Liaison coordinated efforts and connected PEH to TPC Outreach and are set to meet Friday. OC to follow up.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd, Lindero Cyn. Rd, and Russel Ranch Rd. several times this week.

OC canvassed Shoppes at Westlake Village several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed the Marketplace shopping center several times this week. No new contacts.

OC engaged W14 near Vons. PEH has experienced homelessness for many years and remains service resistant.

OC was informed by Eathen, Public Services Director, that a possible PEH was panhandling at the 101 Fwy. Exit. OC met Eathen at the location and attempted to engage IND without success. IND denied a list of resources.
