

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

April 19-23

Agoura Hills:

OC responded to a request from the city regarding a possible encampment in the hills South of town. A resident stated in an email that there are 3 tents somewhere near Lake Lindero and Reyes Adobe Rd. OC canvassed the area with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison, however, we were unable to locate an encampment. OC to follow up tomorrow.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows daily. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd. In an attempt to locate the alleged encampment on the hill South of town. OC was unable to locate. OC contacted JT Manwell who also could not locate an encampment. JT updated Louis Celaya.

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd and Agoura Rd. No contacts.

OC engaged A27 on Agoura Rd. In front of City Hall. OC offered socks and a Hygiene kit. IND accepted. IND is still not interested in receiving services.

OC connected with JT Manwell who stated that it was verified that an encampment had been established on the hillside south of town around Reyes Adobe Rd. However, it appears that it was a temporary site. OC will continue to monitor the area.

OC engaged A06 who asked for OC contact information. OC forwarded phone number.

OC informed JT Manwell about a possible vehicle parked on private property without license plates. OC canvassed the area but did not locate the vehicle.

OC received an updated Homeless Spread Sheet from Louis Celaya, Deputy City Manager, which will allow us to coordinate our numbering system.

OC attempted to locate A26 who was recently seen in the area around I-HOP. OC to continue to canvass the parking lot. Once IND is located, OC to submit an LAHOP. IND has shown interest in going to shelter in the past. IND also has stated that he is interested in returning to Washington State, however, OC would have to speak to a family member or friend on the receiving end prior to setting up the travel arrangements.

Calabasas:

OC spotted C01 on Calabasas Rd and Mullholland. IND has not been seen in the area for approximately 1 week.

OC canvassed The Commons and The Courtyard several times this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed Albertsons and Calabasas High School. OC noticed the gate at the Miller property was opened. OC informed Michael McConville, Management Analyst, and will re-check the area tomorrow.

OC drove by the Miller property where the gate was open yesterday. OC informed Michael McConville that the gate has been closed and locked.

OC did not locate C01 at the Park and Ride. IND must have found another location to camp. OC received a request from the City regarding an IND sitting on the sidewalk along Calabasas Rd. IND was not at the location when OC arrived. OC was informed that Secure All was unable to locate IND as well.

OC engaged C01 on Calabasas Rd. In Old Town. IND was pushing a shopping cart. IND stated that he found a new spot next to an apartment building. IND stated that he is not interested in services but would possibly accept a room in Project RoomKey. IND has a referral submitted in HMIS.

Coordinated with Debbie Larson, Public Safety Coordinator, to speak on Monday April 26th at the Public Safety Commission Meeting.

OC checked in at The Six Restaurant on Calabasas Rd. IND C01 has not been seen loitering in front of the restaurant lately.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with Long Valley and Burbank Security gates.

Malibu:

OC responded to a request from the city regarding a significant number of shopping carts that are being used as storage/transport in Legacy Park. OC located the items near the Malibu Pharmacy. OC updated Susan Duenas, Public Safety Manager and Deputy Espinoza. OC followed up with SD who stated that he ticketed IND for excessive amount of garbage. IND has been spoken to on many occasions regarding this issue.



OC attended the bi-weekly Malibu Homeless Working Group Meeting.

OC spoke to M05 about participating in the Malibu Homeless Working Group. IND is interested in attending the next meeting.

OC was informed about a possible encampment and large amount of garbage at Trancas Creek, under the bridge. OC canvassed the area but did not locate such encampment. OC may have been looking in the wrong area.

OC and Deputy Espinoza located an encampment under PCH at Trancas. M11 is currently working with TPC and is acquiring his Legal Documents. IND to meet with Tiffany this afternoon.

OC engaged M12, male, 60s. IND was previously assisted in returning to his family back east through Project Homecoming. IND arrived in Malibu this morning. IND stated that while residing with his family, he “felt like he was in jail.” TPC and Venice Family Clinic Outreach quickly engaged IND who recently suffered from two strokes prior to leaving Malibu. TPC is attempting to secure a bed at Turning Point. IND will be placed in a hotel room while waiting for a shelter bed. OC to follow up with IND.

OC participated in the Legacy Park cleanup on Friday. No issues to report.

Westlake Village:

OC was contacted by the Principle of St. Judes Catholic School who stated that A27 had slept on campus again. IND has been warned by SD on several occasions. OC suggested the Sheriff be contacted and IND sited for trespassing. IND sleeps in an area that is visible to parents who drop their children in the morning and are concerned about safety. IND is not interested in services.
