

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

May 17 - 21

Agoura Hills:

OC responded to a request from the city regarding an RV parked along Agoura Rd and Cornell. OC canvassed the area but did not locate an RV. It turns out the RV is parked on the Gateway Foursquare Church driveway. The RV belongs to the church and is not associated with homelessness.

OC checked in with JT Manwell on a daily basis.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows four times this week. No contacts.

Calabasas:

OC contacted Deputy Mateo to check in. SD stated that he offered C02, female, 60s or 70s, a ride to Reseda. IND has been talking about traveling to that area. IND has been loitering the Gelsons Market. IND appeared interested in the ride. OC later drove through the parking lot. OC spotted IND seated at a table.

OC canvassed The Courtyard and The Commons four times this week. No contacts.

OC spoke to security at The Commons. No incidents to report. OC canvassed The Courtyard and Calabasas Rd., and Old Town. No contacts.

OC met with Michael McConvile, Deputy City Manager and Alex from Secure All and attempted to engage C02 at Gelsons. Upon arrival, the team connected with Deputy Mateo from LASD who stated that a call came in regarding a concerned resident and IND who was laying on the sidewalk unresponsive. Multiple deputies arrived on scene along with paramedics. IND was sleeping at the time. IND refused assistance and transport to the hospital. Prior to leaving the immediate area, IND was cited for possessing a stolen shopping cart. IND walked to the shopping center and sat down at a table. OC to continue to engage IND upon sighting and offer services.

OC, SD, Secure All and Michael checked the Miller property across the street from Calabasas High School. It was reported that C03 was spotted in the area the previous morning. IND has been camping on the property. IND leaves early in the morning and was not at the location. IND is known to frequent the area on a regular basis. The owner of the property has been informed of the situation. OC to continue to canvass the area for IND.

OC was contacted by a resident who asked for advice regarding her nephew. IND is experiencing homelessness in Van Nuys. Resident is concerned about IND continuing to receive mail at his parents house. IND is suffering from mental health issues, causing conflict within the family. Resident stated that she is going to rent a Post Office Box and Uber IND to receive his mail.

OC spoke to Michael McConville, Deputy City Manager, about an organization he can direct residents to that want to assist with the homeless crisis. OC suggested Hope of the Valley as a place that accepts volunteers and donations. The organization is planning to mark June 15th as a return to normal operations date. OC contacted the Program Manager who gave permission to forward her contact information.

OC was informed that a resident noticed a burned book under the Agoura Rd. Bridge at Las Virgenes. OC checked the area, photographed the book and sent images to Michael McConville. There was also two plastic storage tubs stashed under the bridge. There was no one at the location at that time. OC to continue to check the area and update as necessary.



Hidden Hills:

OC was contacted by the city regarding an IND who has been sleeping in the gazebo on Round Meadow and Mureau Rd. for the last three days. Security has spoken to IND who refused to give his name. IND leaves a mess behind after leaving the area early in the AM. OC checked in at the Round Meadow Gate to verify that the guard has OC direct phone number. OC met with Kerry Kallman, City Manager, to discuss a plan moving forward regarding this IND. OC to stop in the morning and check the location and follow up with the city.

OC checked the gazebo at approximately 5:30 AM, and again at 2:00 PM. The gazebo was vacant on both occasions. OC to continue monitoring the area.
