

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

May 10 - 14

Agoura Hills:

OC checked in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison, on a daily basis.

OC attempted to locate A13 at T.O. Blvd and Lindero Canyon Rd. No contact.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows on four occasions this week. No new contacts.

OC checked in with Danny at the Laundry who stated that A06 has been sleeping inside the building with two other individuals that were not identified. OC spoke to A06 about trespassing at the business.

OC was contacted by JT Manwell regarding an unknown individual on the roof of CVS that could possibly be an individual experiencing homelessness.. Sheriff is on scene and is attempting to talk IND down off the roof. IND is threatening to injure himself. It was later discovered that it is not one of the local individuals experiencing homelessness, rather a local young man with a history of substance abuse. SD eventually apprehended the individual.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd. No contacts.

OC checked in with Louis Celaya, Deputy City Manager and updated on the situation with A27.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed Albertsons Parking Lot. No contacts. OC also checked under the Agoura Rd. Bridge for encampments. No new encampments have been established.

OC canvassed The Commons and The Courtyard on four occasions this week. No contacts.

OC spoke to Deputy Mateo who engaged C01 at The Commons. IND has been released from custody. IND was picked up last week for mental health evaluation.

OC attempted to locate A27 to gain a general idea of INDs location. OC is planning an attempt to engage IND with the MET team tomorrow. OC was unable to locate IND.

OC recieved a request from the city regarding female, 60s who has been loitering in front of Gelsons. OC also recieved a call from the store manager who stated that she was found on the ground unresponsive the day prior. The Fire Department arrived and was able to get her on her feet. IND walked off. OC engaged IND who refused to give her name and did not want to be bothered. OC and the MET Team attempted to engage IND who was agitated and did not engage.

OC and MET located A27 on the corner of Parkway Calabasas and Park Granada. IND accepted a bottle of water. MET asked IND if he was interested in going to a place to get cleaned up. IND refused. MET suggested IND take care of his foot. IND is Ambulatory. MET did not feel that they could take IND against his will upon first engagement. MET stated that they would check on IND in the next few days. MET feels that they will be more justified upon second engagement to declare IND gravely disabled. OC to follow up as situation progresses.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with the Long Valley and Burbank Security Gates. Nothing to report.

Malibu:

Canvassed the Zuma Beach Board Walk on several occasions this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed Central Malibu several days this week. No new contacts.

OC recieved a request from the city regarding an encampment at 29652 Cuthbert Rd. OC and Deputy Espinoza have engaged M17 in the past. IND is currently working with TPC and is waiting for housing. IND's ID shows the referenced address. IND is currently involved in a lawsuit regarding ownership of the property. The house was lost in the Woosley Fire. OC, Scott and Deputy Espinoza to visit IND tomorrow for updates. OC to follow up.

OC, TPC and Deputy Espinoza engaged M17 at 29652 Cuthbert Rd. The property has been fenced off and IND has since moved his 2 vehicles onto the shoulder of the road. IND has a dog who was recently hit by a vehicle resulting in sugery. The dog is suffering from cancer of the mouth. It was suggested that IND visit the vet as the dog is suffering greatly. TPC set an appoinment with Dr. King next Thursday to fill out necessary paperwork. As soon as a bed becomes available, IND to transition off the street. Deputy Espinoza to contact animal control regarding INDs dog to see if there is anything they can do to help.

OC attempted to locate M04 at his encampment. IND was not at the locaiton.

A vaccination event took place at the Civic Center today. Approximately 30 INDs received their second dose and 10 INDs recieved their Johnson and Johnson vaccine.

Westlake Village:

OC attempted to locate A27 at St. Judes Catholic Church. IND was not at the location.

OC was contacted by the MET Team and asked about the location of A27. OC asked around and was informed by JT Manwell, Agoura Hills Public Safety Liaison, that IND was on Agoura Rd. Near Lindero Cyn. OC and the MET Team engaged IND and convinced him that he needed to see a doctor to look at his foot. IND agreed to go to the hospital but was concerned about inability to pay. The team reassured IND that he would not be liable for payment of any hospital bills. IND was transported to the hospital by ambulance. MET Team accompanied the transport. OC to follow up next week.

OC was informed about an encampment next to the Four Seasons Hotel on Lindero Cyn Rd. The encampment is in the brush next to the freeway on ramp. OC to investigate the area on Friday. OC to follow up.

OC attempted to locate an encampment adjacent to the freeway without success. OC to continue canvassing the area.

Other Activities:

OC met with the Admissions and Outreach Manager of West Valley Detox. We discussed the possibility of working together on occasion to outreach individuals experiencing homelessness. Discussions are ongoing. OC to follow up.

OC updated officials from Agoura Hills, Calabasas, and Westlake Village concerning the outcome of IND A27 as he frequents all three cities.

OC has regular calls to update COG Executive Director.
