

## Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

**June 1 - 4, 2021**

### **Agoura Hills:**

OC contacted JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison, who stated that he engaged A06 and A18 this morning at Kanan Rd and T.O. Blvd. INDs were arguing at the time. JT Manwell stated his concern for A18 who is showing physical and mental deterioration. OC attempted to locate both INDs without success. OC to continue to attempt to locate and may contact the MET Team if IND is unable to care for herself.

OC attempted to locate A18 on several occasions this week without success.

OC checked in with JT Manwell daily.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows shopping centers. No contacts.

OC checked in with Danny from Lady Face Laundry who stated that individuals experiencing homelessness continue to sleep in the building. INDs are entering the establishment prior to closing when the doors automatically lock. OC suggested that he contact LASD to request a patrol unit check the building around closing time. OC to follow up with Danny.

OC checked in with Danny on Friday who stated that there has not been any further issues at the facility.

### **Calabasas:**

OC set up a meeting with Michael McConville for Monday June 7<sup>th</sup>

OC canvassed The Commons, The Courtyard, Civic Center, Hilton Hill, Calabasas Rd and Old Town Calabasas. No contacts.

### **Hidden Hills:**

OC checked in at Long Valley Security Gate. Nothing to report.

OC checked in at Burbank Security Gate. Guy, Security Supervisor, stated that there is a possible encampment near the 101 freeway off of Mureau Rd. South of the gully. OC checked the area and did not notice an encampment. OC to continue to monitor the area.

**Malibu:**

OC engaged new contact at Trancas. Female, late 30s early 40s. IND stated that she was traveling on foot and is planning to go to San Francisco. IND to meet up with a friend who is also traveling and performing music at local piers. IND was separated from her friend. OC informed IND of the Monday dinner at the Methodist Church on Morning View. IND stated that she could use a sleeping bag and jacket. OC contacted TPC who donated both items. IND was unable to locate the church on time and called OC. OC to meet with IND tomorrow at lunch on Malibu Rd.

OC received a request regarding an IND, Male, 30s who is a local experiencing homelessness. IND has family in the area who has offered IND help on many occasions. The family is at the point that they do not know what to do. IND has been offered assistance from TPC in the past and has been service resistant up to this point. IND was recently seen exposing himself while sitting down. IND wears a dress and is obese.

OC located M19 and engaged IND regarding the recent complaints from the residents of the community. OC explained that IND should be more aware of how he sits as he is wearing a dress. OC stated that he doesn't believe that IND is exposing himself on purpose, however OC does not want to see IND get in a situation where he is arrested for indecent exposure. IND seemed to agree. OC updated the city of the conversation.

OC attempted to locate Female to deliver a sleeping bag IND requested. IND contacted OC and stated that she was unable to make it to lunch and would like to move the meeting to the following day. OC was unable to reconnect with this IND.

OC met with Father Paul and Herbie to discuss developing a beach clean up program. Counting Coral, a local non profit organization, and St. Aidens Church will partner to promote clean oceans by cleaning up Zuma Beach. The program will give several individuals experiencing homeless an opportunity to work a few hours per month, give back to the community, and bring public knowledge to both issues. OC to give updates as the program moves forward.
