

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

June 20 - 24

Agoura Hills:

OC responded to a request from the city regarding a possible individual experiencing homelessness that was seen at the wash behind Ralphs. OC canvassed the area on both sides of T.O. Blvd. OC did not see anyone.

OC checked City Hall for an individual who was hanging around the Library Parking lot. IND appears to have mental health issues and was seeking a jump start for his vehicle. IND was not causing a disturbance but patrons of the library are concerned. IND was not at the location.

OC possibly spotted above stated IND in the Ralphs parking lot in Malibu. IND was in a white vehicle with its hood up and appeared to be asking for a jump. OC was not able to engaged IND prior to his leaving the area. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows daily front and back. No contacts. No encampments along the wash.

OC canvassed the Civic Center. No individuals experiencing homelessness were hanging out in the area. OC also checked the Recreation Center. No contacts.

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd, Agoura Rd and Kanan Rd. No contacts.

OC contacted JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison, daily for updates.

OC responded to a request from the city regarding an encampment located at the Park and Ride on Kanan Rd. and Canwood St. Female, 40s was laying down on a couch that was most likely dumped at the location. There is a donation box on site. IND did not want to speak to OC. IND was speaking unintelligibly and possibly had a Russian accent. IND is not interested in services at this time. OC notified Louis Celaya. Cal-Trans to pick up the items that were dumped on site. OC to follow up with IND upon next sighting.



OC engaged A06 who is sleeping on the corner of T.O. Blvd and Kanan Rd. In the bushes adjacent to One West Bank. OC submitted an LAHOP # 32619. OC to follow up.

OC was contacted by Louis Celaya regarding an email that was sent to the city. A resident spoke to an IND experiencing homelessness at Lady Face Laundry. OC suspects it is Body. IND is currently working for Door Dash, saving money and helping out at the laundry. OC continues to engage IND. OC to verify that it is Body and update the city.

OC found a Bridge Shelter for A06. IND stated that he would let OC know next week.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Promenade and Calabasas Rd. No contacts.

OC canvassed Albertsons parking lot. No contacts.

No requests from the city this week.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in at Long Valley and Burbank Security Gates. No issues to report.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Central Malibu. IND in a white vehicle at Ralphs parking lot was asking for a jump. OC did not engage IND who appears to match the description of IND spotted at City Hall in Agoura Hills.

OC canvassed Zuma Beach. No contacts.

OC met with Herbie and M03 at the job site in Trancas. IND has been working for several weeks on a project that has been put on hold. Herbie has found other projects for IND to work on but may not be able to continue to employ IND much longer. IND stated that he is grateful for the opportunity and was thrilled to have a reason to set his alarm in the morning. IND is also going to assist with the Counting Coral/ St. Aidens beach clean-up project.

OC assisted serving lunch. Approximately 20 - 25 INDs participated each day.

OC contacted Deputy Espinoza who stated that there was a vehicle fire last weekend. The vehicle belonged to an IND experiencing homelessness. The cause of the fire is currently unknown.

OC met with Father Paul Elder who is funding a beach cleanup program this summer. St. Aidens Church is partnering with Counting Coral, a local nonprofit that focuses on ocean conservation. Approximately 3 or 4 individuals experiencing homelessness will be compensated for their participation with beach clean-up.

OC received an request regarding Legacy Park and the clean-up that will take place on July 2nd. Last week a small brush fire was started at the East end of the park. It is unclear what started the burn. OC to speak to M22 about moving his tent.

OC checked in with security at Ralph shopping center.

OC was notified regarding a fire that was started in a trash pile underneath the Malibu Creek Bridge. M23 was arrested for starting the fire.

OC checked in with Susan Duenas, Public Safety Manager, to update on current issues.
