

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

June 7 - 11

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week.

OC Canvassed Agoura Rd. Kanan Rd. And T.O. Blvd.

OC engaged A06 at Lady Face Laundry. IND was exiting the building after sleeping inside overnight. IND stated that he made arrangements with Danny. OC to verify that IND has permission to occupy the facility. OC is aware that Danny has had issues with other INDs sleeping at the facility.

OC checked with Danny at Lady Face Laundry about IND sleeping inside. Danny stated that he is aware.

A24 is still residing in the area in his vehicle. IND was asleep at the time so OC did not engage.

JT Manwell contacted OC and stated that he engaged an individual experiencing homelessness laying on a couch on Kanan Rd. JT to have the city remove said couch. OC to attempt to locate IND and update.

OC and JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison, engaged IND who was parked on private property at Kanan Rd. and Agoura Rd. IND stated that he used to have a house in Woodland Hills and was displaced due to COVID-19. IND is now living in his camper. IND stated that he was unaware that he was on private property and will move his vehicle. OC to follow up.

OC and JT Manwell engaged male, 30s who was sleeping on a couch on the sidewalk of Kanan Rd., across from Starbucks. IND stated that he is not interested in services and did not want to discuss his situation.. OC to follow up with IND.

OC engaged A24 who stated that he is still working for Door Dash, however, Uber Eats bought out the company and they are in transition. IND is still living in his vehicle.

OC checked in with JT Manwell who stated that the couch that was dumped on the sidewalk on Kanan Rd. Near T.O. Blvd has been removed.

Calabasas:

OC met with Michael McConville, Management Analyst, to do a story on OCs position for the City of Calabasas Social Media Site.

OC canvassed The Commons, Civic Center, Agoura Rd Bridge. One new contact. IND did not want to engage. IND was on the trail at the creek.

OC canvassed The Courtyard. No contacts.

OC canvassed The Commons and spoke to security who stated that there are a couple of new INDs that come through the area occasionally. OC did not recognize INDs in the photos. OC to follow up upon sighting and engagement of INDs.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked the Gazebo on Mureau Rd. Several times this week. No contacts.

OC checked in with Long Valley and Burbank Security Gates.

Malibu:

OC engaged M21 who stated that he has been unable to reach his CM. He also stated that his housing voucher is going to expire soon. OC suggested that he reach out to TPC to find out if they can help with the situation. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Legacy Park. No new contacts.

OC was informed that there have been recent issues with individuals experiencing homelessness at Malibu Rd. Starbucks location. Security is on site to deal with these issues.

OC engaged Male, 30s at Starbucks on Cross Creek. IND stated that he is from Georgia and came to the area to escape the dangers of Santa Monica. OC to follow up with IND.

OC picked up a donation from Malibu Pacific Church. The organization donated socks and hygiene kits to be distributed.

OC canvassed The Promenade, No contacts.
