

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

July 12 - 16

Agoura Hills:

OC contacted JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison, daily.

OC and JT M. spoke about A13 who was to sign up for services at Lutheran Social Services in Thousand Oaks. IND has not located IND to follow up.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows twice this week. No contacts.

OC received a request from the city regarding an individual at T.O. Blvd and Reyes Adobe. Individual appears to be homeless. OC to check the area in the morning and engage IND if sighted. JT M. checked the area and was unable to locate IND.

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd and Reyes Adobe Rd. IND who was spotted near the intersection was not at the location this morning.

Calabasas:

OC was informed that a transient was arrested at The Commons for threatening a security guard. IND has been known to frequent the area and has caused disturbances in the past.

OC was informed that an individual was detained at Lost Hills Rd and Meadow Creek for disturbing traffic. IND will be taken for observation.

OC received an outreach request from the city regarding female, 60s who has been loitering at Starbucks on Agoura Rd. and Las Virgenes. Starbucks has not filed a complaint. OC and Deputy Mateo engaged IND who stated that she took a Cab from LA to the area. IND stated that she is trying to find Tommy Lee, Musician, to talk over some business. SD stated that Tommy no longer resides in Calabasas. IND stated that she attempted to purchase a room at the Good Night Inn but could not due to lack of ID. IND appeared to be under the influence. IND stated that she planned on vacating the property soon. OC to follow up.



Deputy Mateo informed OC of another IND experiencing homelessness that has been sleeping on a bench in Old Town Calabasas. Female, 50s, has a Calabasas address from 2018. IND stated that she has fallen on hard times. Upon engagement, IND stated that she did not feel like talking about her story today. OC stated that he will bring IND a hygiene kit and sleeping bag on Thursday. OC to pick up donation Thursday morning in Malibu. IND was very friendly but stated that she was not feeling well. OC to follow up.

OC checked the Starbucks Store on Agoura Rd. And Las Virgenes. The IND who had been camped on the patio for the last two days was not at the location.

OC contacted Deputy Mateo who stated that he was unable to locate IND who had been loitering at Starbucks. SD stated that he and Officer Moody from MET engaged female in Old Town Calabasas and submitted an LAHOP. IND is interested in housing. OC to meet with IND tomorrow.

OC checked Starbucks on Agoura and Las Virgenes Rd. No contacts.

OC spotted IND at The Commons who has been sleeping on a bench in Old Town Calabasas. OC was to meet with IND to drop off a hygiene kit and sleeping bag. By the time OC caught up with IND, she had moved on. OC to make another attempt tomorrow.

OC canvassed The Commons and Old Town. No contacts.

OC spoke to Michael McConville regarding an August 11th meeting with city council regarding the homeless issues in the city.

Hidden Hills:


OC was informed that IND, male, 30s was contacted by SD and given a trespass warning. IND was sleeping on Round Meadow Elementary School property. IND has been sighted at The Commons in Calabasas. OC attempted to engage IND but was not successful. IND was warned by security not to harass mall patrons. OC checked the Gazebo on the corner of Calabasas Rd and Mureau Rd. No INDs were at the location. OC checked at 6:00 am and 2:00 pm.

OC checked in with Round Meadow Security Gate and Burbank Security Gate.

Malibu:

OC met with Deputy Espinoza and a Fire Investigator with the intent of hiking into Tuna Cyn to investigate the location of last weeks incident. A person of interest has been named and the team stopped to interview two INDs on Las Tunas Beach. Outreach then moved to Topanga Beach where the IND suspected of starting the fire was located and interviewed. SD and Fire Investigator continues the investigation. OC, SD and Investigator did not make it to the location of the fire at this time.

OC was contacted by Joe Copey from LA County Fire to set up a meeting for Wednesday, July 14th at 10:00 am at the bottom of Tuna Canyon. There are several INDs that the investigators would like to speak to regarding the recent fire. OC contacted Deputy Espinoza to include in tomorrows meeting. OC to follow up.



OC, Deputy Espinoza, Arson Investigator Joe Copey and partner hiked Tuna Canyon to locate and interview two individuals who were in the area during the fire last week. INDs are camped in the creek bed. INDs were cooperative and offered what information they had. Another possible witness was spotted walking PCH toward Topanga Canyon. IND was not located. OC to follow up.

OC checked with Securitas at Ralphs. IND was causing a disturbance in front of Subway and CVS. IND left the area prior to security engagement.

OC was informed about an incident that took place at lunch on Tuesday regarding an IND who became aggressive with volunteers and other participants. At the Thursday dinner in Zuma, IND threatened the life of two INDs. Kay Gabbard, volunteer, asked if OC and SD could attend the lunch on Thursday for safety purposes. SD was on a call, but OC and Scott from TPC was able to attend. IND eventually showed up and became argumentative with Kay and Father Paul. OC realized that the IND was previously engaged by OC, Scott, and Deputy Espinoza last week at the vacant lot across from Bluffs Park. SD has INDs information. OC and SD to locate IND on Friday and have a conversation. OC to follow up.

OC attended the lunch at Malibu Rd and Stuart Ranch Rd. Patrick, male, 50 has become aggressive at several recent meals. IND threatened to kill two INDs on Wednesday night. Deputy Espinoza has been informed and briefly engaged IND at lunch today. IND has approached Kay Gabbard, CART Volunteer, and apologized. OC to continue to monitor lunches.

There was an encampment fire under the Malibu Creek Bridge. SD and Fire responded. The cause of the fire is unknown at this time. This is the second fire to occur in the last month at the encampment.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd. No contacts.
OC checked Westlake Village Park. No contacts.
OC participated in the Westlake Village Homeless Study Session
