

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

August 9 – 13

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Agoura Meadows and Twin Oaks Blvd 3 days this week.

OC canvassed Chumash Park and Old Agoura Park. No contacts.

OC engaged A24 who stated that he continues working for Door Dash and is saving money.

OC contacted JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison, daily.

OC contacted JT Manwell who informed OC that A06 has returned to town.

OC engaged A06. IND stated that he has two jobs in Glendora. IND asked if OC could find a shelter in the area. OC was able to locate a service provider in Pasadena. Union Station Homeless Services has an outreach team that IND can contact. OC forwarded contact info to IND who currently has a phone. OC to follow up.

OC checked in with Louis Celaya who informed OC of an RV parked next to Baskin Robins on Kanan and T.O. Blvd. The RV has been parked since Monday. There is a red tag in the window. OC contacted JT Manwell for support prior to knocking on RV door. JT has gone home for the weekend. OC to contact JT on Monday and engage together.



Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons and checked in with security. No issues to report.

OC connected with Michael McConville, Management Analyst, several times this week.

OC received an email from the city regarding C02 who was spotted riding his bicycle on Mulholland Hwy. IND entered the vacant lot across from Calabasas High School. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed The Commons and checked in with security. Male, 40s who OC has engaged in the past is frequenting the area. IND has resided off and on in Calabasas for some time. IND has shown aggression in the past. IND did not stop to speak to OC. OC to follow up.

New contact. Female, 60s. IND stated that she is a traveling Missionary. IND frequents the area periodically. IND stated that she has income and is looking for an apartment. OC to follow up with IND. To be referred to as C06.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in at Long Valley Gate. OC has not received any requests from the city this week.

Malibu:

OC was contacted by Deputy Espinoza who stated that M20 was picked up on Cross Creek and put on a 51/50 hold. IND was walking into traffic and yelling at vehicles. IND did not utilize his Greyhound Ticket that was purchased last week. IND was to travel to Minnesota where his sister was awaiting his arrival. IND's sister was notified that IND did not make it on the bus. IND stated to SD that he had lost his ticket on the way to the bus station. OC to follow up.

OC informed Paul Elder regarding the above stated situation. Paul Elder heads the program Homeward Bound.

OC assisted serving lunch. Approximately 20-25 INDs participated.

New contact. Female, 35. IND is living in her vehicle and arrived in the area two days ago. IND drove in from Las Vegas. IND stated that she was working at a restaurant and was released due to COVID-19. IND then lost her apartment. OC gave IND a resource sheet and will connect IND to TPC upon next engagement. IND stated that she may travel back to Las Vegas. OC to follow up.

OC received a request regarding an encampment across from Moonshadows Restaurant. OC and Deputy Espinoza hiked to the encampment. INDs have been frequenting the area, but no one was there at the time. OC photographed items of concern including a BBQ and two portable propane heaters. OC confiscated and disposed of the heaters. OC updated Susan Duenas, Public Safety Liaison.



OC connected with Deputy Espinoza to check in. SD asked OC for copies of the photos taken at the encampment across from Moonshadows Restaurant. OC sent photos to SD.



OC engaged A27, Male, 40s who continues to walk back and forth on PCH between McDonalds and Jack in the Box. IND was previously picked up for observation in Westlake Village due to his health. IND exhibits sanitary challenges. IND is not interested in services. IND did not stop to talk to OC. OC to inform Daniel Moody of the MET Team that IND's condition is again deteriorating rapidly.

OC engaged M22 in front of Starbucks on Malibu Rd. IND has her leg wrapped in paper towels. IND stated that due to poor circulation, her leg is leaking fluid. IND is not interested in visiting the ER. OC reached out to Daniel Moody of the MET Team via text and voicemail. OC has not received a response. Security of the center will also reach out to express her concern. There are several concerned patrons who shop in the center.

OC connected Dr. King from Venice Family Clinic to M22 who has been loitering in front of Starbucks for approximately 6 weeks. OC has not received a response from Daniel Moody, MET Team. Dr. King cleaned and wrapped the wound on INDs leg but was unable to convince IND to go to the hospital where IND stated that she has had negative experiences in the past. IND displaying more trust with OC and TPC Outreach which is a breakthrough.

OC traveled to Venice Family clinic to pick up medical supplies which will be dropped off to IND tomorrow. OC also picked up a prescription for another individual at the request of TPC. OC to attend to M22s leg in the AM. OC to make another attempt to contact the MET Team on Friday, August 13th 2021.

OC delivered medical supplies to M22. OC re-wrapped INDs leg and will check back on Monday. OC attempted to contact the MET Team and got no response.

OC delivered medication to IND at lunch. Dr. King accompanied OC to Venice Family Clinic yesterday.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed Westlake Village Community Park, T.O. Blvd and Lindero Cyn. RD. No contacts.

Other Activities:

OC attended the COG Homeless Working Group.

OC attended a meeting with LAHSA, LAFH, and Terry Dipple.

OC attended the Calabasas City Council Meeting.
