

## Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

**October 11 – 15**

### **Agoura Hills:**

OC contacted JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison who stated that an IND was seen setting up an umbrella and carpet along T.O. Blvd. near Seven Eleven. OC did not see anybody in the area.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows four days this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd. No contacts.

OC was contacted by JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison, who stated that a woman was approached by a resident on the side of Encinal Cyn. Rd. IND was cooking on a camp stove during high winds. OC has not verified if IND is experiencing homelessness. The incident was published on Next Door on 10/11/21.

OC was contacted by JT Manwell who stated that he engaged an individual experiencing homelessness in front of CVS. IND is traveling through the area and may be heading to Calabasas. JT to forward INDs contact number.

OC contacted JT Manwell who forwarded an individual experiencing homelessness's phone number. IND was engaged in front of CVS yesterday. IND stated that he is traveling to Calabasas. OC to contact IND and update.

OC reached out to an IND that JT made contact with on Wednesday. IND did not give his name but stated that he may travel to the Calabasas area. OC left a message on voicemail.

### **Calabasas:**

OC canvassed The Commons, Albertsons, Civic Center and Calabasas Rd daily. No contacts.

OC checked in with Deputy Mateo. Nothing to report.

OC canvassed The Commons and spoke to security who stated that an IND, possibly the gentleman stated above had been loitering on property and asking for money. IND has not been seen in a couple of days.

OC responded to a request from Juvie, Security at The Commons. A complaint was called regarding a woman who was sitting outside the jewelry store and cutting her hair. OC arrived and was not sure the IND is experiencing homelessness. IND appeared to be hygienic and was only carrying one small backpack and a purse. OC did not engage.

### **Hidden Hills:**

OC received a request from the city regarding an IND who was seen at the gazebo on Round Meadow and Mureau Rd. OC responded and did not see anyone in the area. OC updated Kerry K., City Manager. OC also checked in at the gate. The guard was not aware of the situation.

OC checked the gazebo on Mureau and Round Meadow every morning this week and did not locate anyone in the area.

OC scheduled a HMIS training with city staff on Monday October 18 at 11:30 am.



### **Malibu:**

OC was informed that the IND who was accused of starting the first fire under the Malibu Creek Bridge was given 3 years of probation and released from jail. OC has not seen IND return to the area.

The IND who allegedly started the fire behind Ralphs next to the dumpster is due in court today.

OC attended the Malibu Homeless Working Group Meeting.

OC canvassed Ralphs shopping center. No contacts.

OC canvassed Central Malibu. No contacts.

OC canvassed the encampment on the east end of the Zuma Beach parking lot. OC spoke to several INDs regarding this weekends Red Flag Warning. OC spoke to Deputy Espinoza who will canvass Tuna Cyn to alert INDs of the fire danger in that area.

OC contacted Susan Duenas for update.
