IND is living in his vehicle since 2016. INDs household belongings are in storage in Calabasas. IND stated that he doesn't know where to go. IND stated that rent is too expensive in LA but feels emotionally tied to the area. OC suggested that he think about Safe Parking and gave him a resource guide. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Grape Arbor Park. No contacts.

OC checked in with C07 at Albertsons. IND has not contacted Safe Parking. IND stated that he was on his way out and did not have time to talk.

Hidden Hills:


OC checked in at Long Valley Gate. Nothing to report.

OC and Carmen, security at Ralphs engaged IND who has pitched a tent on the hill behind. IND stated that he missed the last bus to town last night and is planning on moving to the beach. OC to follow up.

OC assisted with the Zuma Beach Cleanup. Two individuals accepted beds at shelter in Long Beach. All other encampments were vacant. The crew finished at approximately 4:00 PM.



OC was contacted by M27, female, 50s. IND is living in her RV. IND is a victim of Woolsey Fire. IND has been waiting for her insurance settlement and is working with TPC. IND inquired about receiving a hotel voucher for a couple of nights per month. OC contacted Tiffany S. who stated that IND is on the housing list but is waiting to be matched. OC to follow up regarding a hotel voucher for IND.

OC checked in with Susan Duenas, Public Safety Manager.

OC was contacted by Chris Frost, Fire Safety, who referred a new contact. M25, male, 40s. OC and Deputy Espinoza spoke to IND at Westward Beach. IND has been in the area for approximately one week. IND has spoken to Tiffany of TPC. IND stated that he is from Palm Springs and has been on the housing list for two years. IND asked where he could go to get housing tomorrow. OC stated that it takes time. OC suggested that he continue to work with TPC. IND stated that he has a new job at Pavilion's.

IND is waiting for an Emergency Housing Voucher which is delayed because IND returned to Florida to be with his family. That situation did not work out and IND returned to Malibu. OC brought IND new clothes and visited over coffee. IND stated that he needed to pick up some groceries for his room. OC took IND to the store. IND stated that he has his own room and three meals per day are served. IND intends to stay at the location until he receives his voucher. OC to continue following up with IND.

Christ Frost contacted OC regarding M07. IND is waiting for his Santa Monica housing voucher. IND is angry because TPC asked him for additional information regarding income verification. IND stated that his CM already has that information. IND became verbally abusive. IND may not be aware that agencies require periodic updates. OC will locate and engage IND on Monday.
