Agoura Hills:

OC spoke to Shane True, LAHSA Outreach, about coming to the area with SD HOST Team. Shane was unable to give a specific date and time because his boss is out of the office today. After their morning meeting tomorrow, Shane will inform OC of a definitive time.

OC updated JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison, regarding this week's upcoming outreach efforts with SD HOST.

OC canvassed Old Agoura Park and Chumash Park. No contacts.

OC completed a daily check in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows. No contacts.

OC to meet with LAHSA/HOST on Monday November 29. We will meet at Lost Hills Sheriff Station and outreach Agoura Hills. OC to follow up.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons, Calabasas Rd and The Courtyard on several occasions this week.

New Contact: Male, 43. C08 has experienced homelessness for many years. IND was sitting at the gazebo on Calabasas Rd. IND is living under the overpass at Avenue San Luis. IND is interested in attending a residential treatment program. OC to meet with IND tomorrow and will call about a bed. OC to follow up.

C08 did not show up for his meeting with OC this afternoon. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Grape Arbor Park and Gates Canyon Park. No contacts.

Contacted Deputy De Mateo for check in. We discussed checking on C02 who is known to camp across from Calabasas High School. IND has been informed that the new property owner does not want anyone camping on site. OC and SD to engage IND next week and offer shelter. IND has been resistant to services in the past.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked the gazebo on Mureau Rd. and Round Meadow. No issues to report.

Malibu:

OC engaged M07 at Westward Beach. IND was still in his sleeping bag. OC attempted to gather information that TPC needs to move forward with his voucher. IND was in conflict last week because he doesn't feel like the outreach workers are doing their job. OC stated that occasionally, IND will need to submit updated information to Section-8 HUD. IND did not want to discuss further. OC updated Tiffany, TPC Outreach. OC to continue to follow up with IND.

OC checked in with Deputy Espinoza daily.

OC requested Deputy Espinoza engage M07 regarding the recent conflict with TPC. TPC requested updated income verification which is required by HUD occasionally. IND became aggravated and threatening. OC attempted to engage IND on Monday without success. Deputy Espinoza stated that IND would reach out to TPC by phone. OC to follow up.

OC checked in with Carmen, Security who stated that the contract with Securitas has been canceled and the property management is using IPS Security moving forward.

OC followed up with Deputy Espinoza regarding M07. IND stated that he will contact TPC to update his information. IND stated that he is frustrated with the length of time it takes to receive housing.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed Westlake Village Park. No contacts.
