

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

December 6 – 10

Agoura Hills:

OC checked in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison. There was a situation over the weekend at the park and Ride on Kanan Blvd. It was reported that two individuals experiencing homelessness were fighting in the parking lot. No other information is known at this time.

OC checked in with JT Manwell who stated that there was an IND asleep in his vehicle at the park and Ride on Kanan and Canwood. IND was not at the location today.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows on several occasions this week.

An unknown IND was panhandling at the intersection of Kanan Rd and Canwood St. OC informed JT Manwell. OC returned an hour later to find that IND had left the area.

OC engaged female, 50s in front of Ralphs. IND was speaking to herself and had several plastic bags with her. IND appeared to be experiencing homelessness but stated that she is not living outside. IND stated that she needed to catch her bus. OC to follow up with IND if seen in the area in the future.

Calabasas:

OC attempted to engage male, 30s C09 at The Commons. IND was wearing a Santa Suit and loitering inside The Corner Bakery. IND has been banned for harassing guests. Security was called by the establishment. IND did not engage with OC.

OC attended Encountering and Serving Individuals Experiencing Homelessness Training.

OC canvassed Albertsons. An IND was sleeping outside Starbucks early this morning. OC did not wake IND. OC did not see IND on the days following this week.

OC checked in with Juvie, Allied Security at The Commons.

OC canvassed Civic Center several times this week.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in at Long Valley Gate. No contacts.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. No contacts.

Malibu:

OC engaged M14. IND has not been in contact with his CM. IND has/had a housing voucher but has not made any attempt to locate housing. OC will continue to follow up with IND.

OC was informed that M31 was detained for starting a fire at the Methodist Church. IND was just released from a 51/50 hold after damaging a local hotel room.

OC checked in with Susan Duenas, Public Safety Manager.

OC and City Staff toured the Tiny Home Village in Wilmington. The facility is operated by The Salvation Army and is very similar to the Tiny Home Villages in the San Fernando Valley.

OC attended the lunch on Friday. Approximately 25 INDs participated.

OC canvassed Zuma Beach. No new contacts.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd and Lindero Canyon. No contacts.
