Agoura Hills:

OC contacted JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison for daily updates.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several days this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd., Kanan Rd and T.O. Blvd. No contacts.

A request from SeeClickFix was submitted by a concerned resident regarding a vehicle that was parked at the chain enclosure of Old Agoura Equestrian facility. IND was behaving strangely and did not speak English. IND left the location.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed Albertsons shopping center several times this week. No contacts.

OC was contacted by Deputy De Mateo who was informed that C02 has returned to his encampment across from Calabasas High School. IND has been service-resistant up to this time. SD suggested that we wait to re-engage IND until the next HOST Team visit.

OC received a request from Juvie, Allied Security at The Commons Juvie stated that an individual experiencing homeless was loitering on site. OC responded to City Hall where IND was thought to have moved. New Contact: Female, 50 (C10). IND has been traveling between T.O. and Calabasas. IND has been contacted in Agoura Hills by the Public Safety Liaison. IND is from NY may be suffering from mental health issues. IND was very polite when engaged but did not accept an offer to go to a program/shelter. IND believes people are following her and harassing her, preventing her ability to stabilize and/or get a place to live. IND stated that she wants to leave the country if possible. OC contacted Daniel Moody, MET regarding IND. OC to follow up.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in at Round Meadow security gate. Nothing to report. No issues at the Gazebo on Mureau have been reported.

OC checked in at Long Valley security gate. Nothing to report.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Legacy Park. No contacts.

OC engaged M11. IND stated that he has been thinking about looking into his housing options. OC stated that the sooner he speaks to TPC regarding housing the better. IND understands that it is often a lengthy process. IND has resided in Malibu for many years.

OC spoke to Dr. King and Dr. Ryan about OC's concern for M11. IND has resided in Malibu for many years. IND stated that he was soaked wet during the rainstorm. IND appears to have been unable or unwilling to seek shelter. IND stated that he may investigate housing options. OC informed the Dr's of the location of INDs encampment. OC to follow up.

OC attempted to locate M11. without success.

OC engaged M30 at Malibu Rd. Starbucks. OC attempted to connect IND to the Dr.'s from VFC. IND stated that she wasn't interested in seeing them, however IND stated she wanted to see the gallows erected.

OC was to meet with Luis Flores, Public Safety Liaison, to canvass Tuna Canyon. OC was called to Calabasas but spoke to Luis about rescheduling for next Monday. OC to follow up.

. Westlake Village:

OC canvassed Westlake Village Community Park. No contacts.

OC checked in with front desk at City Hall. A report was submitted of an IND on T.O. Blvd next to TJ Max. OC suspects it is Dennis. IND has been service-resistant up to this point. IND has family in the area. OC will continue to engage IND and offer services. OC will attempt to locate IND the next time SD HOST Team visits the area.
