

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

January 3 – 7

Agoura Hills:

OC connected with JT Manwell for update. The city is still working on obtaining a letter of agency for the property on Canwood Dr. OC left a message with SD Sheklo of HOST. OC attempting to set up an outreach effort with the team ASAP.

OC canvassed Old Agoura Park and Chumash Park. OC noted a black Mazda in the parking lot which appeared to have been parked overnight. OC notified JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC canvassed Event and Rec Center. OC noted a blue Honda Accord that appears to have someone living inside. No one was in the vehicle at the time and the facility is closed to the public this week. OC followed up on Thursday but did not locate anyone. The vehicle remains parked but appears to have been moved.

OC checked the Park and Ride on Roadside Dr. Nothing to report.

OC engaged A32, female, 60s at Goodwill. IND would not state where she is from. We conversed about Winter Shelter options but did not respond positively. OC stated that he would check with her in the next couple of days.

IND was observed sleeping in front of Goodwill this morning. It may have been A32. OC did not wake IND.

OC and JT Manwell checked on A31 who is living in his van with his brother. They have acquired a third vehicle, white cargo van. IND has not heard from LAHSA.

OC spoke to Shane True, LAHSA, who stated that the organization is on lock down due to COVID and the teams are not outreaching individuals experiencing homelessness at this time.

Calabasas:

OC contacted SD Mateo for update.

OC canvassed The Commons and checked in with Allied Security on several occasions this week.

OC was requested to check the bus stop on Calabasas RD. and Park Grenada Rd. It was reported that a possible individual experiencing homelessness was sitting on the bus bench. OC checked the area and did not locate anyone.

Michael McConville informed OC that an IND experiencing homelessness left a 10-page letter at City Hall. The IND left her name and phone number. OC reached out to IND, female, age unknown. C12 has been living outside for two years after being released from jail. IND stated that she violated a no contact order. IND was speaking rapidly and seems to be suffering from delusions. IND is currently in Compton. IND stated that she would like to return to the San Fernando Valley. OC forwarded IND service provider contacts and suggested that she reach out sooner rather than later. IND was grateful for the information.

OC canvassed Civic Center. No contacts.

OC was contacted by SD Mateo who stated an IND was seen at Mc Donald's drive through pan handling for food. IND has been seen at that location several times this week. OC followed up and did not locate anyone.

OC canvassed Grape Arbor and Gates Canyon Park. No contacts.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in at the Round Meadow Gate. Nothing to report.

Malibu:

OC engaged M21, male, 30s on Cross Creek. IND sleeps at the bus stop and has been service resistant in the past. OC continues to encourage IND to sign up for housing.

OC engaged M11. IND has resided in Malibu for many years. IND has recently hinted at the possibility of exploring housing options. OC spoke to Dr. King recently regarding concern of INDs health. Today, IND had severely swollen hands. IND stated that the condition recurs frequently. OC to attempt to locate IND this Thursday if VFC is in the area.

OC engaged M10 at Malibu Creek. IND has a large encampment in the area. IND remains service resistant. IND has resided in Malibu for many years.

OC, SD Espinoza, and Luis, Public Safety Liaison attempted to locate M32 and his encampment at the top of Tuna Canyon. We were successful in that endeavor. IND does not want housing. IND has a clean and orderly encampment and is very conscious of fire danger. IND has a wound on his left cheek that is not healing. IND stated that it is cancer. We spoke to IND about seeing Dr. King, VFC. IND was receptive of that information. OC notified Tiffany S., TPC, of INDs location. Tiffany has attempted to locate IND recently.

The team located several abandoned encampments on Tuna Canyon. There is a significant amount of garbage in the area. It appears that someone has visited the site very recently.



Westlake Village:
