

## Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

**January 24-28**

### **Agoura Hills:**

OC contacted JT Manwell to set up a time to canvass a property on the Calabasas/Agoura Hills city border. Michael McConville, Management Analyst of Calabasas sent OC a map of the area and we are planning to visit the location tomorrow morning. OC to follow up.

OC updated JT Manwell regarding the individual who has been frequenting the library. IND is experiencing homelessness and living out of his van. The vehicle has out of state plates. Neither OC or JT M. has spotted IND in the area this week.

OC canvassed Old Agoura Park and Chumash Park twice this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed the Event and Rec Center. No contacts.

OC engaged male, 60s who was sleeping at the bus stop on T.O. Blvd and Kanan Rd. IND would not give his name. IND stated that he missed the last bus last night after doing his laundry at Lady Face. IND was grateful that OC woke him up.

OC met with JT Manwell to canvass the area near Davids Rd. that is on the border of Agoura Hills and Calabasas. It was reported that an IND was spotted pacing in a field near a residence. The IND is thought to be experiencing homelessness. The IND was only sighted once in the area. Resident met with OC and stated that he may be camping near the Self-Storage near Lost Hills. OC checked the area but sighted no one. OC to fly drone tomorrow to get a larger view of the area.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week.

OC canvassed Civic Center. No contacts.

OC contacted JT Manwell for daily updates.

### **Calabasas:**

OC was in contact with Michael McConville to coordinate a visit to a property on the Calabasas/Agoura Hills city line. A resident notified the city about a possible individual experiencing homelessness frequenting a vacant field near a residence. JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison of Agoura Hills and OC will visit the area tomorrow morning and send an update.

A vehicle that is parked near the Self-Storage and appears to be being used as storage belongs to C07, male 60s. IND is living in a second vehicle and parks at Albertsons. IND has refused services in the past. IND may or may not be the person wandering around in the brush. OC updated Michael McConville, Management Analyst of Calabasas.



OC responded to a request from the city regarding a possible encampment at the shutdown Coco's restaurant on Las Virgenes. OC photographed a small camp at the back of the restaurant. The location was vacant however, it appears to have been utilized recently. OC updated Michael McConville and Deputy De Mateo. OC to revisit to attempt to locate IND.



OC canvassed The Commons. No contacts.

OC checked Coco's restaurant. It does not appear that IND has returned to the small encampment at the location.

OC received a request from the city regarding an individual who has been sleeping next to the businesses at The Courtyard. OC checked the area but did not locate IND. OC to stop at The Courtyard Thur. morning to re-check the location.

OC flew a drone over the hillside at Self-Storage in attempt to locate any encampments in the brush. OC did not locate any encampments.

OC canvassed The Commons and spoke to security who stated that an IND who has been banned from the property was back yesterday. IND may have been the person sleeping next to Coffee Bean on 2 occasions this week.

Checked in with Michael McConville regarding C13. IND is facing eviction and has received a 3-day pay or vacate notice at Malibu Canyon Apartments. IND has 1 adult and 1 minor children living with her. IND has resided in Calabasas for 9 years. IND is dealing with health issues and is not able to work currently. IND was a flight attendant for 35 years. OC has forwarded several links for housing services. IND is currently enrolled and waiting for approval of emergency rent assistance. OC left IND a voice mail and is waiting for a call back. OC to give update.

OC checked Coco's restaurant for the individual who has a small encampment. Still no contact.

OC received a request regarding an individual who has been sleeping near Coffee Bean on Monday and Tuesday night. IND was not at the location as of 6 AM. OC checked with management who stated that they did not see anyone this morning. OC to follow up.

### **Hidden Hills:**

OC visited Long Valley Security Gate in response to a request from the city. An IND has been sighted at the stop sign along the 101 North freeway entrance. Security Guard stated that she will send OC a photo of IND. IND frequents the area consistently in the late afternoon. OC to follow up.

OC checked the gazebo on Mureau and Round Meadow. Nothing to report.

### **Malibu:**

OC was contacted by Deputy Romero of State Parks regarding two IND's experiencing homelessness. M33, male, 20s was engaged at Adamson House. IND stated that he is interested in receiving services. IND was connected with St. Josephs Center several months prior. IND was driven to a shelter where a bed was available. IND left the shelter and returned to the Malibu area. OC to follow up with IND.

M34, female, age unknown was engaged last Friday night at the Malibu Lagoon. OC contacted IND by phone. IND does not want help with her detox. IND stated OC can connect her with Tiffany S., TPC. IND has been taking Suboxone for nine years as prescribed by a doctor.

OC checked in with Deputy Espinoza daily. Nothing to report.

OC engaged M13. IND stated that he is minimizing his drinking and doing better. IND continues to be service resistant. IND is currently on Probation and Parole.

OC engaged M35 who has begun working with TPC. IND has health problems and may be eligible for a hotel voucher while he waits for permanent supportive housing. IND has frequented Malibu for many years but travels out of state occasionally.

### **Westlake Village:**

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd, Lindero Cyn and Westlake Village Marketplace. No contacts.

OC canvassed Civic Center/library. No contacts.
