

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

January 31 – February 4

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows on several days this week.

OC canvassed Old Agoura and Chumash Parks. No contacts.

OC engaged the cleanup crew at the Canwood St. encampment. The job is going well and no issues to report.

OC canvassed the area next to Agoura Deli. No individuals experiencing homelessness were pan handling at the time.

OC engaged A06 at Starbucks on Kanan Rd. IND stated that he lost his job recently and decided to return to Agoura Hills. IND asked if a shelter bed was available. OC stated that if there was a bed available in the valley and the shelter is not on quarantine, possibly. IND stated that there is too much radiation and is not interested. OC has informed IND many times that there are no options locally. OC to follow up. OC to locate IND the next time HOST visits the area.

OC received a request regarding an IND laying on the sidewalk next to Cronies Restaurant. OC arrived and did not locate IND. OC canvassed the front and back of Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows.

Calabasas:

OC received a request from SD Mateo regarding C14. Male, 28. IND has been seen in the area pan handling. IND was sleeping on the sidewalk next to 7/11. OC engaged and forwarded IND a list of services.

OC checked in with Allied Security at The Commons on several occasions this week.

OC connected with C13 by phone. IND continues to work with service providers.

OC visited C14 next to 7/11 who has been loitering in the same spot for over 24 hrs. IND reminded him to utilize the resource guide. IND was meditating and did not want to be bothered.

OC checked in with Deputy Mateo several times this week.

OC received an update regarding C14 from Deputy Mateo. SD stated that IND was arrested on Wednesday night.

Received an update from Karen who continues to work with the Rotary Club. IND is interviewing with staff this evening. IND is also meeting with SSI late this month.

Hidden Hills:

OC received a request from security at Long Valley Gate regarding an individual that frequently is seen pan handling at the stop sign at 101 freeway entrance. OC arrived approximately 15 minutes after the call. Unfortunately, the IND was not at the location. OC to continue to monitor the area.

Malibu:

OC engaged M35. IND continues to work with TPC. IND stated that he needs shoes. OC forwarded the request to Kay Gabbard, CART Volunteer who often receives shoe donations.

OC assisted with lunch. Approximately 25 INDs participated. VFC Dr's King and Ryan met with several INDs as they do weekly. OC referred M11 to Dr. King.

OC and Luis, Public Safety Liaison met with M11 at Legacy Park. IND has a small encampment across from the Labor Exchange. OC offered IND several garbage bags. IND stated that he would have the area cleared by Monday. OC, Luis and SD Espinoza to follow up on Monday AM.



Luis and OC checked in with Melissa, Library Manager regarding an IND who has returned to town with his family. IND's are living in a large RV and have been parked overnight in the parking lot. IND's were not at the location today. A conversation was had last evening with library security and IND left the immediate area.

OC attempted to locate A13 who sleeps in front of Duncan Donuts. IND was not located.

OC canvassed The Promenade, Westlake Village Blvd, and Reyes Adobe Rd. No contacts.
