

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

February 7- 11

Agoura Hills:

OC received a notification of a possible individual or group of individuals experiencing homelessness sleeping in Forest Cove Park over the weekend. OC was not in the area on Monday. JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison canvassed the area but did not locate anyone. OC to follow up Tuesday morning early.

OC responded to a request from the city regarding Forest Cove Park. OC canvassed the area and did not see any signs of an encampment.

OC engaged A06 who stated that he was returning to Glendora to pick up his paycheck.

OC engaged A33 Male, 30s. IND was standing in the middle of parking lot intersection at Vons. OC gave IND a resource guide. IND was not speaking coherently.

OC completed a daily check in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison for updates.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several days this week.

OC checked in with JT Manwell who stated that he noticed a couple of new individuals traveling through town. It was not verified if those individuals are experiencing homelessness. OC canvassed the area later in the afternoon and did not contact anyone.

OC checked in with Danny at Lady Face Laundry. Nothing to report.

OC engaged A33 at Ralphs. IND was looking at the phone plans. OC to continue to engage IND.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed Civic Center and The Commons. Juvie, Allied Security stated that there have been no issues to report lately.

OC canvassed Albertsons. No contacts.

OC contacted SD Mateo for updates. Nothing to report.

OC received a report from SD regarding an individual who was contacted on Old Topanga Cyn. The area is in California Parks jurisdiction. OC has received little information. OC to follow up.

OC checked in with Michael McConville, Management Analyst.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in at Long Valley and Burbank Gates. Nothing to report.

OC checked in with Long Valley gate at 4:00 pm. The IND who has been pan handling at the stop sign was not at the location. Security Guard has not seen IND today.

Malibu:

OC, Luis and SD Espinoza engaged M11 in Legacy Park. IND had not cleaned or vacated his encampment over the weekend. SD gave IND the rest of the afternoon to gather his belongings. IND continues to be service resistant.

OC met with SD Espinoza and canvassed the vacant lot across from Bluffs Park. M26 had a warrant for a camping ticket and was sited out for a new court date. No other individuals were seen on the property.

OC checked Legacy Park with SD. A small encampment remains that needs attention. IND was not at the location.

OC received an email regarding a possible encampment at Trancas and PCH. CalTrans has left several large culvert pipes for an upcoming project along PCH and it is thought that an IND is camped inside. Luis, SD Espinoza and OC to check the area tomorrow morning. OC to follow up.

OC met with Luis, Public Safety Liaison and West Coast Care Outreach Team at the Santa Monica Pier. We rode along with the Team to observe their efforts. The team contacts individuals experiencing homelessness on the beach and attempts to reunify INDs with family.



OC, Luis, and SD Espinoza responded to a request from the city regarding an IND who may be sleeping in the culvert pipes along PCH at Trancas. We checked the location and found several culverts that contained personal belongings. No one was currently at the location. OC to follow up

New contact, male, 40s. IND was engaged in front of Starbucks on Malibu Rd. IND has been seen in the area for the last week. OC informed IND of the lunch program in hopes IND would engage with TPC Outreach Team. OC did not notice IND at lunch. OC to follow up.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed Westlake Village Park. No contacts.

OC checked in at City Hall. An IND experiencing homelessness has been seen leaving the parking lot around 7:00 in the morning. IND is sleeping behind the offices but does not leave any signs behind. OC to attempt to locate IND Wednesday morning early.

OC canvassed the City Hall / Library building to locate an unknown IND who has been sleeping on the property. OC arrived at 6:30am but did not locate IND.

OC engaged W03, female, 60s who was sleeping in her vehicle at Civic Center. OC is familiar with IND who had resided in the Malibu area in the past. IND is currently working with a service provider in the T.O. area. IND is waiting to be placed in housing. OC will continue to follow up with IND.

OC engaged two individuals experiencing homelessness at Civic Center. It was approximately 7:00am. W01, male, 40s was walking off property. OC believes this is the IND who has been sleeping at the site lately. IND continues to be service resistant.

A second IND was packing up his gear when OC arrived. IND refused to speak to OC. OC updated Tim Iverson, Safety Inspector, regarding both INDs.
