

## Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

**June 20 - 24**

### **Agoura Hills:**

OC canvassed Twin Meadows. OC engaged Tara who was sleeping behind Starbucks. IND has set up an encampment. Store employees are aware of the situation. IND packed up her belongings and walked off.

OC attempted to engage A06 who was agitated as the result of being provoked by another individual. Sheriff deputies were called by a customer. IND left the area prior to SDs arrival. OC explained the situation with SDs.

OC checked in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC engaged A06 who has been asked not to loiter at Starbucks due to the situation that happened on Monday. IND stated that he will visit DMV on Thursday. OC to follow up.

OC attempted to engage C23. IND did not engage.

LAHSA responded to LAHOP # 48262. The outreach team was unable to locate IND.

OC engaged A06 at Lady Face Laundry. IND stated that he would visit the DMV today to order his replacement ID. OC to follow up.

### **Calabasas:**

OC canvassed Albertsons. No contacts.

OC canvassed The Commons and Civic Center. No contacts.

OC stopped by Gates Canyon Park to meet Secure All who will be checking the bathrooms on Sun, Mon, and Wed. C19 continues to lock herself in the public restroom. IND was seen walking out of the park without her shopping cart. OC did not meet with Secure All. OC to follow up this Wednesday.

OC met Secure All at Gates Canyon Park. C19 was not located at the location.

OC was notified that an individual experiencing homelessness was sleeping on a mattress at the bus stop on Park Granada Rd. and Calabasas Rd. IND left the area prior to OC arrival. SD Mateo was at the location. City to clean up the bus stop.



OC received a request regarding a possible encampment on the utility trail next to Park Sorento. OC to follow up. OC notified SD Mateo.

OC followed up on a request from the city regarding a possible encampment on the utility trail along Park Serento Rd. OC and SD Mateo walked the path. No encampment was located. Two large box springs were dumped near the entrance to the path. Michael McConville, Management Analyst has been informed.



### **Hidden Hills:**

OC was informed that an individual experiencing homelessness has been sleeping on a bench outside of Long Valley Gate. Sheriff Deputies were notified and contacted IND on the weekend. The HOST Team made contact with IND; however, she did not meet the necessary requirements for a 51/50 hold. IND remained Sunday night and left the area Monday morning. OC followed up with security on Tuesday.

### **Malibu:**

OC attended lunch. Approximately 25 INDs participated.

OC attempted to attend “Coffee with Cops” at Trancas Starbucks. The event was cancelled.

A family of four, who’s vehicle broke down, was connected to services. C.A.R.T. and St. Josephs are splitting the cost of a hotel room for several days. The family was on their way to Oxnard where they are working with a service provider. OC to follow up.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 30 INDs participated. VFC and TPC was onsite assisting INDs. St. Josephs met with the family to transport to a hotel.

OC canvassed Civic Center early in the AM. No contacts with individuals experiencing homelessness.
