

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

July 5 – 8

Agoura Hills:

Daily check in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows on several occasions this week.

Checked in with Lady Face Laundry manager.

Calabasas:

OC responded to a request regarding a possible encampment in the trail along Park Sorento Rd. OC walked the trail and did not locate an encampment. A shopping cart containing items that possibly belong to an individual experiencing homelessness was located at the beginning of the trail near the cul-de-sac. Other small items were located further down the trail. OC canvassed Old Town Calabasas. No contacts.



OC responded to a request from the city regarding an IND who reached out over the weekend. OC contacted IND by phone and forwarded a contact list for services. IND sent a lengthy email to the city. OC to follow up with IND and discuss his options. OC informed SD De Mateo.

OC was informed that an IND was contacted near Lovi's Restaurant and was detained for displaying behavior that was dangerous to herself and others. IND was taken for mental health evaluation.

OC canvassed Albertsons shopping center. No contacts.

OC and SD De Mateo met with C25 at the Tennis and Swim Center. IND stated that he flew in from Indiana and has family there. IND maintains contact with his parents. IND came to L.A. to work on his business project. OC directed IND to DPSS for services. IND notified OC later in the day that he was able to sign up for food stamps, cash assistance and Medi-Cal. OC to follow up. It remains unclear if IND will return to the area.

OC was notified that C02 was engaged by SD on Old Topanga. IND stated that he is heading to a location on Stunt Rd.

OC checked in with Allied Security at The Commons. An IND was detained last night to making threatening gestures toward security. IND is unknown to OC. OC did not locate IND.

OC canvassed Civic Center. No contacts.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with Long Valley Gate. Nothing to report.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. on several occasions. No contacts.

Malibu:

OC participated in the Malibu Homeless Working Group.

M38 approached OC at Starbucks on Malibu Rd. and asked for assistance locating PCH. IND has a worsening vision problem. OC stated that it is becoming very dangerous for IND to be walking around town in his condition. IND has been service-resistant in the past. OC notified TPC and VFC of INDs worsening condition. The team located IND who is now willing to accept assistance. TPC to meet with IND on Monday to complete intake and locate medical services that accept INDs insurance. OC to follow up.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 30 INDs participated. TPC, VFC, and SJC was on location meeting with INDs.

OC checked in with SD Espinoza and Luis F. Public Safety Liaison.

OC was notified that an individual experiencing homelessness and allegedly breaking into vehicles was located and detained.

Westlake Village:

OC checked in with city hall staff. No contacts with individuals experiencing homelessness.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd. and T.O. Blvd. regularly. No contacts.
