

The People Concern Malibu Outreach Team

June 2022 Report

Narrative

Outcomes

In June 2022, the total number of contacts made by the outreach team was 179, with 49 unduplicated contacts. 9 individuals were contacted in permanent or temporary housing. Of the 49 unduplicated contacts, 19 were new contacts, with 10 of them becoming repeat contacts. There are currently 125 individuals on the streets of Malibu that have been previously engaged. 62 are considered in various stages of engagement, and 63 are refusing services at this point. The outreach team continues to contact these individuals with the goal of getting them engaged in the housing process.

Success Story

In the month of June, the Malibu outreach team seen a surge in families new to the area. One particular case involves a family of 7 whereas the outreach team was determined to find a solution that would allow for them to take the next steps in obtaining permanent housing. Although the family has not yet been permanently housed, the outreach team was able to identify their needs and referred them to St. Josephs whom specialize in assistance with homeless families. In addition, the outreach team linked the family to Venice Family Clinic to which they now have a medical provider to address any medical needs and concerns.

Community Interaction

The outreach team will continue to support and work in partnership with CART, LAHSA, the City of Malibu, Malibu Public Library and the Los Angeles County Sheriffs Department. As outreach efforts continue to grow, the outreach team will continue to identify and reach out to other community groups and organizations with the common goals of providing assistance to the homeless population.

Next Steps

The outreach team has recently expanded outreach operations to include RV's and motorized vehicles in the region. In an effort to engage and identify as many homeless as possible, the outreach team will continue to expand outreach efforts to those whom have not had any contact in the past.
