Agoura Hills:

OC engaged A24 at Lady Face Laundry. IND Cleans the facility and checks to make sure the doors are locked at closing time. IND stated that he is working part time at a local convenient store as well as his job at Door Dash.

OC checked in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison who stated that a Letter of Agency will be available this week for use at Agoura Meadows. OC to follow up with Danny at Lady Face Laundry this week.

OC received a complaint from the library regarding A01. IND continues to camp in front of the entrance to the building. IND has been disturbing other guests and staff at the facility. OC met with Melissa who is filling in as manager. OC also notified JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison, who updated library staff of the situation.

OC submitted LAHOP #51552 for A01. OC forwarded a copy to Jessica, COG Administrator, and Kimberly B. at LAHSA.

IND may have family in another state. IND is shy and has not shared much information. OC gave IND a hygiene kit, two new T-shirts and a resource guide. OC to follow up with IND who may be a good candidate for the Homeward Bound program. IND may qualify for services at SFVCMHC as well.

OC checked in with SD De Mateo daily.

OC was contacted by Daniel Moody, MET regarding an IND at The Commons. Allied Security has had several complaints from guests regarding INDs behavior. Moody to submit LAHOP. OC attempted to engage IND on a previous occasion. IND did not engage.

OC met with Michael, Security Manager, The Commons and The Promenade, to discuss homelessness in the Calabasas area. Michael started his position in July and is curious about OC's position. OC forwarded a resource sheet and discussed homelessness issues.
