

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

October 24 – 28

Agoura Hills:

OC engaged A39 at Kanan Rd. IND continues to wait for her ID. IND was agitated and became aggressive stating that OC is attempting to steal her SS funds. OC disengaged. IND continues to sit along the roadside.

OC engaged A31 at Canwood and Lewis cul-de-sac. IND stated that he lost his job but waits in the area for his brother. IND stated that no assistance was provided from the HOST Outreach team. OC suggested IND contact Safe Park LA. OC submitted LAHOP # 54031.

An RV has been parking at the cul-de-sac on Canwood and Lewis. OC and JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison knocked on the door without response.

OC was informed that A39 may have been arrested for occupying a lane of traffic on Kanan Rd. IND returned to the location the following morning but was gone by the time OC arrived. OC updated Daniel Moody, MET.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week.

OC checked in with Louis C., Deputy City Manager.

Daily check in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC checked the cul-de-sac on Lewis Rd. The white van has not been seen at the location for several days. The RV has moved to the opposite side of the street. It appears that no one is living in the vehicle and may belong to a resident of the community. OC to follow up.

Calabasas:

OC was notified that an IND continues to camp along the creek under the Agoura Rd. Bridge. OC located a small encampment that contained mostly garbage. OC updated Michael McConville, Management Analyst.

OC engaged M13 at McDonalds and asked if he was staying under the bridge. IND became agitated and aggressive and denied camping in any specific area.

OC verified that the Agoura St. Bridge was cleaned up.



OC engaged Male, 40s who has been in the area for several weeks. IND was friendly but denied camping under the bridge. OC notified Michael McConville. that there may be several INDS sleeping under the bridge. Secure All will check the location in the evening when there is a better chance of engagement. OC to follow up.

OC and SD De Mateo hiked the hill across from CHS. C15 continues to remove his belongings from the site. Items that pose a fire danger were located. OC updated Michael McConville. IND was not at the location.

OC canvassed The Commons and checked in with Allied Security. Nothing new to report.

OC scheduled a cleanup of C15's camp across from CHS to take place Wednesday, October 26th at 2:00 pm.



City Staff, SD De Mateo, and OC completed the camp cleanup across from CHS.

OC received a request from the city regarding an IND who is dwelling in his vehicle (C31). IND was arrested last week for trespassing in Hidden Hills. IND was located and engaged in Calabasas on Friday. IND is from out of state and suffers from mental health. OC suggested that he contact a safe parking provider or other services. OC forwarded a resource sheet. OC left a message with Daniel Moody, MET. OC updated Michael McConville, Management Analyst, and Kerry Kallman, Hidden Hills City Manager. OC to follow up.
