

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

Outreach Coordinator canvasses all five COG cities daily.
Below is a summary of coordinators activities.

January 2 – 6

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd, Kanan Rd and Agoura Rd. several times this week.

OC canvassed Civic Center. No contacts.

OC attended a meeting with Louis C., JT M, LHSD, and local business management to discuss issues with individuals experiencing homelessness.

OC checked in with JT Manwell who stated that he made contact with the IND park in an RV at the vacant lot on Kanan and Agoura Rd. IND stated that he thought he could park at the location. IND was informed that he was residing on private property.

OC checked in with Dane, LAHSA Outreach who contacted A35 last week. Minimal engagement took place. Outreach was not able to locate A06, but contact was made in the evening by text. OC working on coordinating a follow up effort for next week.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons several times this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed Calabasas Rd and Old Town on several occasions. No contacts were made.

OC responded to a request from the city and reached out to an IND who left a request on the city's homeless portal. OC left a message and forwarded a list of resources to INDs email.

OC contacted female, age unknown by phone. C35 submitted an outreach request on the City Portal. IND was forwarded a list of resources and OC suggested she contact SFVCMHC after discussing INDs situation. OC to follow up with IND next Monday. It is currently unclear where IND is residing.

Hidden Hills:

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week. No contacts.

OC checked with security at Long Valley Gate. Nothing to report.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Zuma Beach. No contacts.

OC canvassed Central Malibu several times this week. No new contacts.

OC was notified of a large family who are living in their SUV. INDs were directed to the lunch location.

OC spoke to Daniel Moody, MET regarding several INDs who frequent the malibu area. HOME Team is working with M62 who has not been seen in the area for several days.

HOST to post a no camping notification at Surf Rider Beach this week. Two INDs have established encampments along the bluff.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 25 INDs participated on Tuesday.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 20 INDs participated on Friday.

OC attempted to engage male, 40s at Starbucks. IND was agitated and appeared to be intoxicated. IND was walking in front of traffic and frightening guests. OC contacted LHSD and IND was detained for shoplifting from Whole Foods early this morning. IND has generated several prior calls to LHSD.

Westlake Village:

OC checked in with the city staff. No issues were reported with INDs experiencing homelessness.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd and T.O. Blvd on several occasions this week. No contacts.
