Outreach Coordinator canvasses all five COG cities daily.  
Below is a summary of coordinators activities.

February 6 - 10

### **Agoura Hills:**

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week.

Daily check in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC met with John C., Salvation Army Veteran Employment Services. John works locally and specializes in assisting Veterans gain employment whether they are homeless or residing in the community. OC to follow up.

OC engaged A39 at Starbucks on Agoura Rd. IND was intoxicated and drinking in public. IND remains service resistant and became verbally hostile. IND panhandling in front of business. OC informed JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Kanan Rd., T.O. Blvd., and Agoura Rd. several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Old Agoura Park and Chumash Park. No contacts.

### **Calabasas:**

OC engaged C17 who is staying at the Midnight Inn. IND receives income and has resided in the area for several years. IND remains service resistant.

OC canvassed Albertsons shopping center several times this week. No new contacts.

Daily check in with SD De Mateo.

OC canvassed The Commons and Civic Center several times this week. No contacts.

OC, Secure All and SD De Mateo engaged C28 who was camping along the Trader Joes building on Calabasas Rd. IND continues to refuse services. IND was given a warning by SD De Mateo for the second time.

OC was informed that C37 was seen walking around town. OC contacted SD De Mateo who stated that he made contact with IND who stated that he was going to the library. SD reminded IND that there is a no camping ordinance in Calabasas.

**Hidden Hills:**

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week.

OC checked with security at Long Valley Gate. No new contacts with individuals experiencing homelessness.

**Malibu:**

OC canvassed Central Malibu. No new contacts.

OC engaged M65 at Starbucks on Malibu Rd. IND stated that he may look into the Homeward Bound program. IND arrived several months ago from Minnesota. IND has family out of state that can receive him. OC to follow up.

OC engaged M64 to speak about housing services. IND continues to insist that he may not remain in the area much longer. IND has been service resistant in the past. OC suggested that he work with TPC because he has all his legal documentation in order. OC to follow up.

OC checked in with SD Espinoza.

OC engaged M67, female, 40s at Starbucks. IND has returned from out of state. IND was last engaged in Malibu two years ago. OC was able to enroll IND in a transitional housing program in the valley. IND returned to her family. IND stated that she was not getting along with her brother who also lives at IND's father house. IND decided to return to CA. OC to follow up.

OC connected M64 to TPC to sign up for services. IND stated that he may not remain in the area long enough to acquire housing. OC suggested IND complete an intake regardless. IND has all of his legal documentation required for housing. OC to follow up.

**Westlake Village:**

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd. several times this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed Westlake Village Community Park. No contacts.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd. and Lindero Cyn Rd. several times this week. No contacts.
