

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week. No new contacts.

Daily check in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison. A39 continues to store belongings at the bridge access near Trader Joes on Canwood.

LAHSA Outreach notified OC that they made contact with A35 on Tuesday. IND stated that she was not interested in being entertained.

OC canvassed Old Agoura and Chumash Parks. No contacts.

OC canvassed Kanan Rd., Agoura Rd., and T.O. Blvd. several times this week. No new contacts.

Calabasas:

OC and LAHSA Outreach engaged C28 at Coffee Bean to offer services. IND stated that he is not interested in going to a winter shelter program.

OC and LAHSA Outreach engaged C26 at The Commons. IND accepted a business card but was reluctant to discuss services.

OC and LAHSA Outreach was not able to engage C37, as IND left the area prior to LAHSA's arrival. OC and Michael McConville working with SFVCMHC Problem Solving program to assist INDs unification with family out of stated. OC to follow up.

OC was informed that an individual experiencing homelessness broke into a garage near a local business. SD DeMateo attempted to locate IND who ran from the location.

OC attempted to locate C37 at Civic Center early in the morning without luck. LAHSA was not able to locate IND in the afternoon. Library staff stated that they had not seen IND for several days. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed The Commons several times this week.

OC checked in with Michael McConville for update.

Daily check in with SD De Mateo.

OC received a request from the city regarding IND, female who asked about finding a shelter. IND stated that she wasn't willing to go into a congregant situation for safety reasons. OC forwarded Winter Shelter contact information. OC also contacted LAHSA Outreach who stated that Winter Shelter is full. OC to follow up.

Hidden Hills:

OC was contacted on Saturday regarding an IND who was setting up a tent at the gazebo on Round Meadow. OC notified SDs and city staff. SD Knott responded to notify that camping was not allowed at the location due to the close proximity to a school zone. IND stated that he was heading North to San Francisco. OC checked the location on Monday and discovered a abandoned shopping cart. OC notified city staff who removed the items.

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. Nothing to report.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week.

Malibu:

M68 has returned to the area. IND frequents Malibu for many years and suffers from mental health. MET has been notified. IND was in jail and appears to be pregnant. OC to follow up.

M32 has been placed in transitional housing at TPC. IND has been camping on Tuna Canyon for several years.

M58 continues to work with VPAN for housing. IND stated that he has a appointment in two weeks.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 20 INDs participated on Tuesday and Thursday.

M26 is showing interest in transitional housing. TPC continues to engage.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed Westlake Village Community Park. No contacts.

OC checked in with city staff at Civic Center. Nothing to report.
