Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week. No contacts.

OC checked the bridge access near Trader Joes on Canwood. The gate has been locked and the area clear.

OC was notified by LAHSA Outreach that they contacted A35 this week. IND remains service resistant.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd., Kanan Rd., and T.O. Blvd. several times this week.

OC received a request from the city regarding an IND who has been causing a disturbance at the shopping center at Kanan and Agoura rd. near Agoura Deli and Mart. OC checked with Management of the jewelry store who hasn't seen the IND since last week. SD were called on several occasions. OC to follow up.
