### **Agoura Hills:**

Daily check-in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC engaged A43 at Agoura Deli Mart. IND resisted engagement and walked away. OC updated JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows shopping centers several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd., Kanan Rd., and T.O. Blvd. several times this week. No contacts.

OC was contacted by SD Baldi regarding A43 who caused a disturbance at DYI. OC confirmed that several engagements have been made and that IND is service resistant. IND was trespassed from the property. OC updated JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC canvassed I-HOP parking lot several times this week. No contacts.

### **Calabasas:**

OC received a request from the city from the city portal outreach request site. New contact: Male, 30s. C38 was located on Calabasas Rd. in Old Town. IND has been on the streets for approximately 45 days. IND is eager to return to work and needs to replace his ID. IND stated that he is reluctant to enter a shelter. OC contacted Nancy, LAHSA Outreach, and will attempt to engage IND tomorrow. OC updated Michael McConville.

OC received a request from LHSD regarding IND camping in the playground at De Anza Park. SD De Mateo and OC arrived to discover IND had fled the area. IND was not located.

OC canvassed The Commons and Civic Center several times this week. No contacts.

OC and LAHSA Outreach engaged C38 in Old Town to discuss IND's specific needs. IND is not willing to enroll in a shelter. IND needs to replace his ID and sign up for DPSS services. LAHSA willing to assist with transportation if needed. OC to follow up.

OC contacted C38 who stated that he set up a time to meet with LAHSA who will provide transportation to the DMV and DPSS. OC to follow up.

OC responded to a request that was sent to the city homeless outreach portal. OC forwarded the link to LAHOP because the location of the request was in Los Angeles. OC updated Michel McConville.

OC responded to a request from the city regarding a possible encampment in the bushes near the bus stop on Calabasas Rd. and Parkway Calabasas Rd. OC spoke to the landscapers who were working in the area who stated that there were items in the bushes last evening but were removed by this morning. OC updated Michael McConville.

OC engaged C38 by phone. IND stated that LAHSA Outreach transported him to DPSS today. IND was able to enroll in the CalFresh, GR, and Medi-Cal programs. IND will visit the DMV next week to replace his ID. IND also stated that he may have found a room to rent locally. OC to follow up.

**Hidden Hills:**

OC checked in with Long Valley gate security. Nothing to report.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week. No contacts.

**Malibu:**

OC was contacted by Luis F. Public Safety Liaison who stated that several INDs were camping at Zuma Beach entrance. No camping signs will be posted and area to be cleaned. OC to outreach the area tomorrow.

OC was notified that an unknown IND was sleeping along PCH near Ralphs parking lot entrance. OC verified that IND was not injured and alerted SD Espinoza who responded and asked IND to move to a safer location.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 25 INDs participated.
