II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A residential burglary was reported on Pacific Coast Highway. A window screen was removed from a second-floor bedroom window and the window smashed to gain entry. The victim arrived and found the suspect in the back patio area, a male, who fled. (23-01284)

An Anaheim resident was arrested for possession of a stolen golf cart on Malibu Canyon Road. The suspect admitted to stealing the golf cart, returned it two days later and was apprehended. (23-01331)

An attempt residential burglary occurred on Broad Beach Road. A call for service was received of a male adult in a blue Dodge Ram pickup truck attempting to make entry into a residence under construction at the location. When deputies arrived, the pickup truck was found and discovered to be a stolen vehicle. The vehicle was stolen from the jurisdiction of the Los Angeles Police Department's West Valley Division. Video footage showed that there was an additional suspect. (23-01124)



SCHOOL ISSUES

Responded to Malibu High School for bullying incident. Suspicious Circumstances report taken.

Responded to Malibu High School regarding student in possession of THC vape pens.

J team notified of fight involving Malibu HS and Oak Park students at house party in Oak Park and In n Out in Westlake Village. Both incidents appeared to be related. Ongoing investigation.

Responded to Malibu High School regarding student in possession of cannabis vape product.

INTERVENTIONS

Follow-up investigation conducted regarding vandalism incident involving Malibu HS students. All parties non-desirous of criminal prosecution upon completion of follow up.

Conducted 6Pack of photo line-up with victim and family at Lost Hills Station regarding sales of HC to ca minor (Webster Elementary).

Counseled Malibu HS regard possession of cannabis vape pen on campus at LHS. Student was referred to DYD CHAMPS diversion program. Student cited regarding incident. student receptive to counseling.

COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

1. We spoke with numerous citizens and parents who called to question various juvenile concerns and issues in the community. We also provide the parents with resource programs within our community.
2. We inquired with the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney regarding the investigation and filing of criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
4. Met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo throughout the month to keep her up to date regarding our unit's investigations and current juvenile issues within our city.
5. Entered juveniles into the Youth Diversion program for various violations.
6. We-investigated, prepared, and filed cases with the District Attorney's office. We additionally assisted other investigators in the preparation of cases for court.
7. Met with station narcotic detectives to exchange information regarding juvenile and drug related issues.
8. Handled the processing and follow-up of various juvenile referrals brought to the attention of this unit for various juvenile contacts with uniform personnel.
9. Conducted our normal checks of juvenile problem areas in the city during weekend evenings and responded to juvenile related calls for service.
10. Assisted Patrol re: CARP, backfill behind patrol/shortage, mandatory overtime.
11. Ongoing investigation on THC sales to Webster Elementary school student. Discovered possible child pornography case upon further investigation.

12. Ongoing investigation on THC sales to a minor incident at Malibu HS

13. Registered 1 Sex Registrant in city of Malibu jurisdiction.

14. Presented J Team Drug Awareness presentation to 6th – 8th grade students at our Lady of Malibu School. Discussed topics regarding dangers of drugs, gateway drugs and controlled substances.
