

## Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

**May 1 – 5**

### **Agoura Hills:**

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week. No new contacts.

Daily check-in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC and SD De Mateo engaged IND who was pan handling on the center divider near the Kanan Rd. and Roadside St. intersection. IND stated that he and his family are from Anaheim, Ca. OC forwarded a list of resources.

OC canvassed Kanan Rd., Agoura Rd., and T.O. Blvd several times this week.

### **Calabasas:**

OC arrived at the scene of an active situation involving LHSD and an individual experiencing homelessness at The Courtyard. IND was threatening individuals and establishments with a machete. Due to the dangerous situation, OC was unable to engage. OC verified that the IND was not known in the area previously. SDs were able to take IND into custody. IND was transported by ambulance to the hospital for observation.

OC canvassed The Commons and Civic Center several times this week.

OC and LAHSA Outreach engaged C38 in Old Town. IND requested transportation to N. Hollywood to pick up his mail at LA Family Housing. IND opened a bank account and is waiting for his debit card. LAHSA gave IND a TAP card so that he could use Metro for transportation. IND has received DPSS benefits and has also replaced his Driver's License. IND plans on renting a vehicle so that he can apply for jobs. OC suggested IND look for a Safe Parking Program. OC to continue to follow up with IND.

OC and SD De Mateo met with Albertsons Manager to discuss the recent increase in homeless activity and how to respond to shoplifters. OC verified that there are no encampments in the area. Management to complete an LOA and submit to LASD.

OC canvassed Creekside Village several times this week.

OC updated Michael McConville, Management Analyst.

OC witnessed C28 exiting the business park next to Trader Joes early this morning.

### **Hidden Hills:**

OC checked in with security at Long Valley gate. Nothing to report.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week. No contacts

### **Malibu:**

OC engaged M63 at Starbucks on Malibu Rd. IND asked OC for assistance with transportation to Best Buy to purchase a new electronic device. OC to transport next week.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 10 INDs participated on Tuesday and Friday.

OC engaged M58 at lunch. IND stated that his housing has been approved and is scheduled to pick up his keys on Thursday with Bruce, VPAN.

OC verified that M58 signed his lease and received his keys on Friday.

OC checked in with SD Espinoza who stated that a large RV has been towed due to an excessive amount of unpaid parking tickets.

### **Westlake Village:**

OC was informed by the city regarding an individual who may be experiencing homelessness and living in her vehicle that frequents City Hall. IND is aggressive and leaves a large amount of garbage behind. SDs have dealt with IND in the past. OC asked city staff to reach out next time IND is seen in the area.

OC was informed that INDs dwelling in their vehicle may be sleeping at Westlake Village Community Park overnight. OC checked in with staff at YMCA. Staff are concerned that the park gates are not being closed at night by City Parks. OC to check the area early tomorrow morning and moving forward. INDs may be parked in the back corner near the Skate Park. OC to update Phillippe E., Deputy City Manager.

OC canvassed Westlake Village Community Park at 6:30 am. No vehicles that appear to have been parked overnight were sighted in the area. OC spoke to SD who was at the location. SD also has concerns that the park entrance is not being locked during overnight hours. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Civic Center at 6:45 am. OC did not locate any vehicles in the lot.
