

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

May 15 – 19

Agoura Hills:

Daily check-in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week. New contact: Male, 50s. (A46) IND stated that he is a veteran, however IND was speaking incoherently and was difficult to understand. OC was unable to obtain much information from IND. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Morrison Park several times this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed Agoura rd., Kanan Rd. and T.O. Blvd several times this week.

OC and JT Manwell used a city truck to canvass the hillside on the fire road at the vacant lot on Agoura Rd. and Kanan Blvd. No encampments were located. A small number of items remain at the vacant site near the front of the property.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons, The Courtyard and Civic Center several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Old Town and engaged C26 who was sleeping on the porch of a vacant building across from Sagebrush Cantina. IND remains service resistant. OC reminded IND that there is a no camping ordinance in the City of Calabasas. IND removed his belongings and moved on.

OC met with Michael McConville, Deputy City Manager for updates.

OC responded to a request from SD regarding W04 who was blocking the sidewalk on Parkway Calabasas. Secure All arrived prior to OC and asked IND to move along. IND stated that he was waiting for the bus back to Westlake Village. IND remains service resistant.

OC canvassed Old Town several times this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed Gates Canyon Park and spoke to maintenance workers. No individuals experiencing homelessness have been seen in the area.

OC canvassed Grape Arbor Park. No contacts.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. Nothing to report.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week. No contacts.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Central Malibu and engaged M64 who stated that he is working with TPC. TPC verified that IND had completed his intake for services a while ago and might need to update his VI-SPDAT assessment. TPC has INDs documentation on file and is waiting to be matched for housing. IND remains forgetful and would benefit greatly from an updated assessment.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 25 INDs participated on Tuesday and Thursday.

OC transported M63 to Van Nuys for his court date. IND received a positive outcome. IND remains on the housing list and continues to work with TPC.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed Agoura Rd., T.O. Blvd, and Lindero Canyon Rd. several times this week. No new contacts.

W04 continues to generate calls for setting up on the sidewalk. IND travels between Calabasas, Agoura Hills, and Westlake Village. IND remains service resistant.

OC checked in with city staff and canvassed Civic Center. No contacts.
