

## Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

**May 30 – June 2**

### **Agoura Hills:**

OC engaged IND, male, 40s on Roadside at the Park and Ride. IND has been panhandling at the 101 freeway exit for approximately one week. OC forwarded a list of resources. IND stated that he is from Washington State and is service resistant. OC to follow up.

OC engaged IND, male, 30s at Chevron Station. IND ignored OC and did not accept a list of resources. IND does not appear to be experiencing homelessness but cannot verify.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd., Agoura Rd., and Kanan Rd. several times this week.

OC checked in with Danny at Lady Face Laundry.

Daily check-in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC and JT Manwell located a vacant white van on Liberty Canyon that has generated calls to the city. The registered owner has a local address, and it does not appear that anyone is living inside.

OC notified JT M. that an IND was seen pan handling at the 101 freeway exit on Kanan. IND has been seen in the area frequently and does not appear to be homeless. OC attempted to engage IND earlier this week. IND ignored OC. JT notified Highway Patrol.

### **Calabasas:**

OC was notified by SD De Mateo that C28 was arrested for trespassing at Trader Joes. IND became aggressive while attempting to detain.

OC canvassed Calabasas Rd. and Old town several times this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed The Commons, and The Courtyard several times this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed Civic Center several times this week. No contacts.

OC contacted C39 by request from city staff. IND is being evicted from her apartment. OC referred IND to LA Family Housing for Problem Solving Services.

OC was notified that C28 was arrested overnight on Wednesday for trespassing at The Courtyard for the second time this week.

OC followed up with C39, female, age unknown regarding a request that was received by the city. OC suggested IND reach out to LAFH earlier this week for assistance with INDs apartment lease. IND failed to connect with the organization as of today. IND stated that she has worked with them in the past and had a Case Manager assigned. IND asked if she should attempt to re-connect with CM. OC affirmed that was a great idea. OC to follow up early next week with IND.

#### **Hidden Hills:**

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. Nothing to report.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week. No contacts.

#### **Malibu:**

OC engaged four INDs experiencing homelessness that were camping at the entrance to Legacy Park on Cross Creek. OC notified SD Espinoza who arrived and informed INDs of the no camping ordinance. INDs were also informed about the local outreach efforts in the area. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Central Malibu.

OC canvassed Surf Rider Beach. No contacts.

OC attended lunch on Friday. Approximately 20 INDs participated.

OC was informed that the four INDs that were contacted in Legacy Park on Wednesday have left the area.

#### **Westlake Village:**

OC checked in with city staff who stated that the IND who has been causing issues in the parking lot has returned. It remains unclear if IND is experiencing homelessness. IND was not in the parking lot at the time OC was there. IND was recently arrested and placed on a mental health evaluation hold. OC to follow up.
