

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

August 14 – 18

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd., Kanan Blvd., and T.O. Blvd. several times this week. No contacts.

OC was notified that the truck/trailer on Agoura Rd. and Liberty Cyn. Has been ticketed and tagged.

OC checked in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison, and notified him that the Truck/Trailer has returned to Agoura Rd. and Liberty Canyon.

As of Friday, Both Truck/Trailers have returned to Agoura Rd. and Liberty Cyn.

OC verified that No Trespassing signs have been posted on the vacant lot at Kanan and Agoura Rd.

OC received a request from the city regarding an IND who is living in his vehicle at Forrest Cove Park. New Contact: A51, Male, 60s. IND stated that he was staying with his family but it did not work out. OC suggested IND contact Safe Park LA. OC forwarded a list of resources and will follow up with IND next Monday.

Calabasas:

OC was notified that an IND that may be experiencing homelessness has been seen for the second time sitting on the sidewalk near residences at Park Sorrento. OC was unable to locate IND. OC updated Michael M. Deputy City Manager.

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed Calabasas Rd. and Old Town Several times this week. No contacts.

OC engaged SDs at De Anza Park who were responding to a call regarding an IND that was causing a disturbance. IND may have been experiencing homelessness and was agitated. OC did not engage IND who was walking toward Las Virgenes.

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard. An IND experiencing homeless was arrested at The Commons after becoming aggressive with security guards on Tuesday night.

OC contacted Dane, LAHSA Outreach, to set an appointment for Friday to engage C41 at Creekside Village to see if IND would like to utilize a shelter bed at SFVCMHC. OC updated Michael M., Deputy City Manager.

OC was unable to connect with LAHSA Outreach on Friday. OC to follow up next week.

OC contacted an IND by phone after receiving a request that was submitted through the city's website outreach portal. IND was interested in low-income housing opportunities that are planned. OC sent a list of homeless resources.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. OC was notified that two individuals experiencing homelessness were caught entering the development unlawfully. They were escorted out without incident.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Central Malibu. No new contacts.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 30 INDs participated on Tuesday.

OC engaged M26 who stated that he is waiting to move into Turning Point once a bed becomes available. IND stated that he lost the replacement BC that he recently acquired. IND also stated that he is clean from hard drugs and is taking medication.

OC met with Luis F., Public Safety Liaison and canvassed Trancas, Zuma, and Dan Blocker beach and located a small encampment beyond the fencing in a drainage ditch. The lock on the gate has been cut. OC notified TPC. We also hiked into Malibu Creek, East of the bridge and did not locate any encampments.

OC attended lunch on Thursday. Approximately 30 INDs participated.

Westlake Village:

OC checked in with city staff and canvassed Civic Center. Nothing to report.

OC canvassed Westlake Village Community Park. No contacts.
