II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

Community Contacts / Activity:

- Conducted foot patrols of known transient encampments throughout the Malibu RD. Multiple camps abandoned and unoccupied.
- Conducted multiple foot patrols of Legacy Park and the Malibu Library area. Spoke with numerous transients and gathered intel regarding the information and homeless situation.
- Conducted numerous traffic stops warning/advising drivers (See arrests/citations).
- Conducted numerous drivers parked along Pacific Coast Highway in the areas of Coastline, Topanga, Tuna Canyon, Malibu Pier (Eastside of Malibu). Warned drivers regarding illegal parking violations. Drivers were receptive regarding our warnings and left the location.
- Patrolled beaches in malibu (Zuma, Broadbeach, Westward), enforced drinking and overnight camping laws.

Assists / Calls for Service:

- Assisted Malibu units with a person drunk in public acting belligerent. The disturbing party left the location prior to our arrival and was unable to be located.

SCHOOL ISSUES

- SMMUSD on summer break.
- Coordinated with all schools (public and private) in Malibu that are serviced by Lost Hills Sheriff's Station to schedule safety walk-throughs and critical incident tabletop scenario exercises (for staff).
- Assisted Malibu Elementary regarding a burglary incident.

INTERVENTIONS

- Counseled two juveniles and parents regarding a burglary incident in Malibu. Juveniles and parents were receptive to counseling.

COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

1. We spoke with numerous citizens and parents who called to question various juvenile concerns and issues in the community. We also provide the parents with resource programs within our community.
2. We inquired with the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney regarding the investigation and filing of criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
3. Met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo throughout the month to keep her up to date regarding our unit's investigations and current juvenile issues within our city.
4. Entered juveniles into the Youth Diversion program for various violations.
5. We-investigated, prepared, and filed cases with the District Attorney's office. We additionally assisted other investigators in the preparation of cases for court.
6. Met with station narcotic detectives to exchange information regarding juvenile and drug-related issues.
7. Handled the processing and follow-up of various juvenile referrals brought to the attention of this unit for various juvenile contacts with uniform personnel.
8. Conducted our routine checks of juvenile problem areas in the city during weekend evenings and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.
9. Assisted Patrol re: CARP, backfill behind patrol/shortage, mandatory overtime.
10. Conducted transient monthly sex registrations for 290 registrants in the city of Malibu jurisdiction.
11. Follow-up conducted regarding Malibu Elementary burglary case regarding additional information provided for additional person involvement.
12. Follow up investigation with father of victim at Lost Hills Station regarding 245 PC incident that occurred at Point Dume in Malibu
