

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

October 16-20

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week. No new contacts.

OC engaged new contact: Male, 30s. IND was pan-handling in front of Mc Donalds. IND stated that he was passing through the area and walked away. IND was not interested in speaking to OC.

OC engaged A06 at Mc Donalds. IND has not been seen in the area for a couple of months. IND stated that he may accept a shelter bed. OC to contact LAHSA for referral.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd and Kanan Rd. several times this week. No new contacts.

Daily check-in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC was informed that an IND possibly experiencing homelessness was seen at Civic Center on Thursday. OC followed up on Friday, however IND was not located.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week.

OC canvassed Civic Center and checked in with desk staff.

OC canvassed Creekside Village and checked in with Starbucks Manager. Nothing to report.

OC checked in with SD De Matteo.

OC was notified by Allied Security at The Commons of an encampment that was in the bushes at Calabasas Rd. and Parkway Calabasas. IND was seen by security using a hose that is accessible nearby. IND did not have any clothing on at the time. By the time OC and Glenn, Security Supervisor arrived, the IND had walked off. IND is most likely C20 who has not been seen in the area for many months. SD De Matteo verified that C20 was arrested several days ago for public intoxication. Property maintenance was notified, and the area was cleaned up.



Items thought to be of value were bagged and will be held for 30 days by Allied Security. OC updated Michael McConville, Deputy City Manager.

OC followed up on the encampment located at Calabasas Rd. and Park Granada on Friday. The area remains clear.

OC received an outreach request from the city portal. OC left a voice mail and sent a list of resources to INS's e-mail on Thursday. OC left a second Voice Mail on Friday.



Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week. No contacts.

Malibu:

OC engaged M03 at Starbucks. IND has been housed but has been spending a significant amount of time in Malibu. IND is between jobs currently. OC suggested IND investigate possible employment with LAHSA due to his lived experience. OC believes it would be a good fit.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 30 INDs participated on Tuesday and Thursday.

OC verified that M56 has been cleaning up his encampment at Zuma Beach entrance.

OC met with Luis F, Public Safety Liaison, TPC Outreach and Jonah G, Housing and Homeless Liaison from Lindsey Horvath's office. We outreached Central Malibu including Ralphs shopping center, Legacy Park and lunch on Malibu Rd.

OC engaged female, 50s who stated that she is traveling back to San Diego soon and is working with a service provider in that area.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed Shoppes at Westlake Village. No contacts.

OC canvassed Westlake Village Community Park. No contacts.
