II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A Malibu transient was arrested for assault and criminal threats on the Pacific Coast Highway. The suspect attacked the victim for unknown reasons. (23-05143)

A transient was arrested for theft and trespassing on Sweetwater Canyon Drive. The suspect climbed over the fence to enter the backyard of the location and turned on multiple water hoses.

A transient was arrested for arson on Pacific Coast Highway. The suspect set multiple pieces of torn cardboard on fire.

A Malibu transient was arrested for theft and vandalism on Civic Center Way. The suspect entered the location, selected store items, and exited without paying. A store employee stated that the suspect entered the business three times that day and each time stole store items.

Eight vehicle incidents (seven vehicle burglaries and one theft from an unlocked vehicle) occurred on Pacific Coast Highway in the areas of Malibu Lagoon and Surfrider Beach. Some of the victims placed their vehicle keys underneath their vehicle or nearby. When they returned, the vehicle keys were missing, and property was stolen from inside the vehicle. In seven incidents, the stolen credit cards were used by unknown suspect(s) to make unauthorized purchases. Property stolen consisted of cell phones, wallets, credit/debit cards, vehicle/house keys, fanny packs, and cash.



SCHOOL ISSUES

Conducted a Critical Staff Scenario tabletop exercise for Malibu Elementary School

INTERVENTIONS

There were no incidents that required intervention during this time.

COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

1. The Juvenile Team received calls from concerned citizens and parents regarding various juvenile issues in the community. We provided them with information about resource programs within our community.
2. We inquired with the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney regarding the investigation and filing of criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
3. Throughout the month, we met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo to keep her up to date regarding our unit's investigations and current juvenile issues within the city.
4. Entered juveniles into the Youth Diversion program for various violations.
5. We investigated, prepared, and filed cases with the District Attorney's office. Additionally, we assisted other investigators in the preparation of cases for court.
6. We met with narcotic detectives at the station to discuss information regarding juvenile and drug-related issues.
7. Handled the processing and follow-up of various juvenile referrals brought to the attention of this unit for various juvenile contacts with uniform personnel.
8. Conducted our normal checks of juvenile problem areas in the city during weekend evenings and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.
9. Assisted patrol regarding CARP, backfilled behind patrol shortages and worked mandatory overtime.
10. We conducted a monthly sex offender 290 registration within the jurisdiction of Malibu.
