II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

An attempt robbery occurred on Pacific Coast Highway. The victim was taking a nap in her vehicle when she was awakened by an unknown male adult suspect reaching into her vehicle through the sunroof. The suspect was attempting to steal the victim's purse. The victim and suspect struggled over it and the victim was able to pull the purse out of the suspect's hands. The suspect fled on foot. A Transient was arrested for residential burglary and mail theft on Pacific Coast Highway. There were no signs of forced entry. Entry was made via the home office at the residence. (23-02110)

A Torrance resident was arrested for residential burglary on Malibu Road. There were no signs of forced entry into the home. The stolen property was recovered during the arrest. (23-01982)

Twenty-three vehicle incidents (19 vehicle burglaries, 3 vehicle vandalisms and 1 theft of a vehicle) occurred on Pacific Coast Highway during the same date and time frames. Surveillance footage showed two suspects in a silver vehicle. The stolen vehicle was recovered by the Los Angeles Police Department's South Traffic Division.
