

ACTIVITY REPORT FOR OCTOBER 2023
MALIBU**

SCHOOL ISSUES

- Assisted Malibu HS regarding a student with a knife on campus.
- Conducted annual safety walk-thru at Malibu Middle and High School.
- Conducted Critical Incident tabletop scenario training for staff at Malibu High School
- Assisted Malibu Middle School regarding possible threats to the school by a student.

INTERVENTIONS

Counseled a student regarding bringing a knife onto campus; the student was referred to a diversion program.

COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

1. The Juvenile Team received calls from concerned citizens and parents regarding various juvenile issues in the community. We provided them with information about resource programs within our community.
2. We inquired with the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney regarding the investigation and filing of criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
3. Throughout the month, we met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo to keep her up to date regarding our unit's investigations and current juvenile issues within the city.
4. Entered juveniles into the Youth Diversion program for various violations.
5. We investigated, prepared, and filed cases with the District Attorney's office. Additionally, we assisted other investigators in the preparation of cases for court.
6. We met with narcotic detectives at the station to discuss information regarding juvenile and drug-related issues.
7. Handled the processing and follow-up of various juvenile referrals brought to the attention of this unit for various juvenile contacts with uniform personnel.
8. Conducted our normal checks of juvenile problem areas in the city during weekend evenings and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.
9. Assisted patrol regarding CARP, backfilled behind patrol shortages, and worked mandatory overtime.
10. We conducted a monthly sex offender 290 registration within the jurisdiction of Malibu.
11. Assisted a Detective with a photo lineup regarding a robbery case in the city of Malibu involving two adults.
12. Participated in Active Shooter drill training at Malibu City Hall for employee training.
13. Ensured record sealing procedures were initiated for juveniles who completed the CHAMPS diversion program for minor offenses.
