

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

December 11-15

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week. No new contacts.

OC attempted to engage A06 who was walking on Kanan Rd. IND was agitated and was verbally abusive toward OC.

OC canvassed Old Agoura and Chumash Parks. No contacts.

Daily check-in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC and JT Manwell responded to a city request regarding an encampment on Roadside. The encampment was located on a vacant lot near 28448 Roadside. The encampment was vacant at the time. JT has contacted the property owner and will acquire a LOA. OC to follow up.

New contact: Male, 50s. A53 was at Civic Center waiting for the library to open. IND was living with his mother locally and was evicted. Law enforcement was involved in the situation and IND placed on a 51/50 hold. IND has contacted Hope of the Valley and is expected to make an appointment for intake. IND is on the winter shelter waiting list. OC encouraged IND to work with HOV and will follow up with IND.



OC followed up with A53 on Fri. IND has completed his intake at HOV and is on a waiting list for Tiny Homes.

OC was contacted by Louis C. Deputy City Manager regarding A35. The owners of Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows shopping centers have submitted updated LOAs and expect them to be enforced by LHSD. OC continues to work with Daniel M. MET to coordinate a solution regarding transitional housing for IND. OC to follow up. OC to meet with Daniel tomorrow to discuss CARE Court.

OC and JT Manwell engaged A35 to see if IND would like a voucher to renew her ID. IND was resistant.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard. OC engaged female, 60s who had exited a bus on Parkway Calabasas. OC had spoken to IND last Friday at The Commons. IND stated that she is sheltered. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Civic Center and checked in with city staff.

OC checked in with Allied Security at The Commons.

OC canvassed Calabasas Rd. and Old Town several times this week.

OC engaged female, 70s at Coffee Bean in The Courtyard. C45 refused to give OC her name. IND has been in the area for several days and denies homelessness. IND is service resistant. OC submitted LAHOP #72018. OC updated Michael M., Deputy City Manager.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week. No contacts.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Legacy Park. No encampments were located however, OC was notified that several INDs may be sleeping in the area overnight. There is an area near Cross Creek within park boundaries where INDs are congregating during the day. INDs are also storing their personal items in shopping carts. OC verified with TPC Outreach that most INDs are actively engaged with services except for one or two INDs. It does not appear that the population is growing, however personal items are accumulating. OC updated Luis F. Public Safety Liaison and will complete a walkthrough with OC and SD Espinoza on Thursday to encourage INDs to limit the items stored and clean up the area. No camping signage is being prepared and will be posted in January.

OC checked in with SD Espinoza.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 20 INDs participated on Tuesday and Thursday.

OC contacted SD Espinoza and updated him on several locations in Legacy Park where individuals experiencing homelessness have been seen sleeping overnight.

OC, Louis F, Public Safety Liaison and SD Espinoza engaged INDs who have been using Legacy Park to store their personal belongings to discuss the feasibility of consolidating their items. Most of the clutter is being caused by a few INDs. Several INDs who are service resistant have packed up and moved on. Signage for the park is expected to be installed at the beginning of next year. We also canvassed the park and did not locate any encampments.
