



08/01/23	Cooking Fire	20455 ROCA CHICA Dr	Food in Oven caught on fire by the upper oven heating coil. Fire out on arrival. No damage to oven or extension behind oven or ventilation system.	
08/03/23	Rubbish Fire	30310 PCH	Trash or rubbish fire, contained	
08/06/23	Cooking Fire	20460 PCH	Cooking fire, confined to container	
08/17/23	Pole Fire	18862 PCH	Power Pole Fire ignited from arcing sparks landing on trash and grass/combustible materials at base of power pole, fire burned up to lower communication lines and power lines.	
08/17/23	Rubbish Fire	31346 BROAD BEACH	PEH started a small bonfire on the beach. LG Area 34 arrives on scene and PEH extinguishes fire and leaves scene. Area 34 makes sure there are no hot embers and dismantles the fire pit.	
08/20/23	Fire, other	19124 PCH	Resident burning paper in empty pool. Fire was extinguished upon arrival.	
08/30/23	Vehicle Fire	PCH & TRANCAS Cyn	Front passenger seat cushion fire, extinguished prior to arrival with dry chemical extinguisher. Vehicle was unoccupied, likely caused by hot item left on seat.
