ACTIVITY REPORT FOR DECEMBER 2023
MALIBU**

SCHOOL ISSUES

- The J-Team assisted Malibu Middle School with follow-up actions regarding a burglary and vandalism incident.
- Malibu Schools on winter break.

INTERVENTIONS

COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

1. The J-Team received calls from concerned citizens and parents regarding various juvenile issues in the community. We provided them with information about resource programs available in our community.
2. The J-Team contacted the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney to inquire about investigating and filing criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
3. Throughout the month, we kept Captain Jennifer Seetoo updated on our unit's investigations and current juvenile issues in the city.
4. The J-Team entered juveniles into the Youth Diversion Program for various violations.
5. The J-Team helped prepare and file cases with the District Attorney's office and assisted other investigators in court preparation.
6. The J-Team met with narcotic detectives at the station to discuss information regarding juvenile and drug-related issues.
7. The J-Team handled the processing and follow-up of various juvenile referrals brought to the attention of this unit for various juvenile contacts with uniform personnel.
8. The J-Team conducted routine checks of areas frequented by juveniles in the city on weekend evenings and responded to calls related to juvenile issues.
9. Assisted patrol regarding CARP, backfilled behind patrol shortages and worked mandatory overtime.
10. The J-Team conducted monthly and biennial sex offender registrations within the Malibu jurisdiction.
11. Follow-up investigations were conducted regarding a 242 PC incident at Malibu Treatment Center.
12. The J-Team reached out to the Malibu schools for consultation regarding the appropriate placement of a second Knox Box.
