

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

January 22 - 26

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week and engaged A52 at Starbucks. OC offered IND some chips and water. IND declined. IND is service resistant.

Daily check-in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC canvassed Old Agoura Park. The RV that was parked adjacent to the park was not at the location. OC updated JT Manwell.

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd, Agoura Rd, and Kanan several times this week.

OC canvassed I-Hop shopping center. No contacts.

OC and JT Manwell attempted to engage IND, female, age unknown who appears to be dwelling in her vehicle at the cul-de-sac on Clareton Dr. IND stated that she is not interested in receiving services. IND was located during last night's PIT Count.

OC was notified that Daniel M, MET, was unable to locate A35 today. OC spoke to Daniel to remind him of her usual locations. Danile to forwarded OC contact info. to HOME Team to coordinate another effort. OC to follow up.

OC submitted LAHOP # 74717 regarding the IND who is dwelling in her vehicle at Clareton Dr. OC to follow up,

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Civic Center and checked in at the front desk. Nothing new to report.

OC canvassed Calabasas Rd and Old Town several times this week.

OC canvassed Creekside Village several times this week. No new contacts.

One of the PIT Count teams informed OC that they located eight vehicles that appeared to be used for dwelling space by INDs experiencing homelessness. OC canvassed the area and visited the sites noted on the map. OC was only able to verify one of those locations which OC was aware of and has been thoroughly noted prior to the count. OC will continue to check each location to verify that INDs are not dwelling in their vehicles.

OC checked the small vacant lot near Shell Station on Calabasas Rd. OC witnessed C28 exiting the stated lot. IND stated that he is not camping on the site. OC asked IND if he is ready to accept a shelter bed at SFVCMHC. IND denied the offer and walked toward un-incorporated Calabasas. OC updated Michael M, Deputy City Manager.

OC and Michael M, Deputy City Manager scheduled an appointment to follow up on the location that were mapped during the PIT Count. Several vehicles were noted that possibly may be used for personal dwelling. OC and Michael M canvassed the area on Friday and did not locate any vehicles being used as dwellings. OC to continue to check the locations and follow up.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. Nothing to report.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week. No contacts.

Malibu:

OC engaged M47 at Starbucks to follow up with our previous discussion about continuing to work with TPC after the last situation for housing did not work out. IND is reluctant and wants to work on housing herself. OC to continue to follow up with IND.

OC canvassed Central Malibu. No new contacts.

OC and Luis F, Public Safety Liaison placed notification of clean-up signage at an encampment on the hillside of Rambla Orienta. IND was not at the location. OC and Luis to follow up early next week.

OC canvassed Trancas and Zuma Beach. No new contacts.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed Agoura Rd and Lindero Canyon Rd. No new contacts.

OC was assigned to work Westlake Village on Tuesday nights PIT Count. No INDs experiencing homelessness were seen in the area.
