Agoura Hills:

OC received a request from the city regarding a follow up on the encampment at Kanan and Cornell. OC and JT Manwell to check the area to see if there have been any changes and possibly contact INDs in the area.

OC, JT Manwell and LHSD, HOST Team attempted to contact the INDs who are camping at Kanan and Cornell without luck. Luis C. continues to work with the property manager to organize a clean-up.



OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd and Kanan Rd. several times this week.

OC canvassed I-HOP parking lot several times this week.

OC and JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison engaged new contact: Male, 60s. (A54) is dwelling in his vehicle and was located parked in the Fed-Ex Parking lot. IND stated that he travels around and works periodically. OC suggested IND investigate a safe parking program and forwarded a list of resources. OC to follow up.

OC was informed of a possible encampment behind The Lexington Apartments. OC located several chairs and an old pillow couch on the hillside. It does not appear to be a camp. OC updated Louis C, Deputy City Manager.



Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Calabasas Rd and Old Town several times this week. No contacts.

OC canvassed Civic Center and checked in with Michael M, Deputy City Manager.

OC canvassed Grape Arbor Park and Canwood St up to the kennels. No contacts.

OC responded to a request from LHSD regarding a female experiencing homelessness who was sitting on the shoulder of Mureau Rd. in an unsafe location. SDs received several calls from concerned residents. OC arrived and had a brief discussion with IND. IND was speaking incoherently. OC suggested Daniel Moody, MET contact IND. Contact was made and IND agreed to leave the side of the road due to safety. IND walked toward the bus stop at Las Virgenes.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. Nothing to report.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow. No contacts.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Central Malibu. New contact: Male, 60s. (M83) is new to the area and stated that he is a Veteran. OC suggested IND contact VPAN which he was not aware of. OC forwarded contact information. IND may be interested in connecting with TPC Outreach. IND was planning on traveling to Turning Point. OC informed IND that TP is a closed facility. OC to follow up.

OC followed up with M83 who stated he contacted VPAN and should hear back from the organization within several days. OC stated that VPAN will be able to assist with housing and other needs.

OC checked in with SD Espinoza who stated that he was going to locate a new encampment at Point Dume on the bluffs. OC to follow up.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 30 INDs participated.

OC was notified that M64 will accept a bed at Turning Point and move in on Thursday.
