### **Agoura Hills:**

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week.

OC connected with IND who left a request on the city website Outreach Portal. OC is waiting for a call from Home Again, Program Manager and will connect IND to that program. (C48) to work with Rotary Club to enhance her resume.

**Hidden Hills:**

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd and checked the gazebo on round meadow several times this week.

**Malibu:**

OC attempted to engage M64 to discuss the importance of working with VFC for health concerns. IND did not wish to engage. OC to update. Dr. King.

OC checked in with Luis F. Public Safety Liaison.

OC engaged C24 to see if he was still working with VPAN. IND stated that he may be interested in housing. OC contacted Bruce G, Outreach who stated that IND is working with TPC. OC to follow up.

OC and Luis F, Public Safety Liaison canvassed Las Tunas Beach and engaged five INDs who are dwelling in their vehicles. OC forwarded a list of resources to each. INDs did not appear interested in services. Two INDs stated that they were leaving the area in the next couple of weeks. One of the RV's was vacant at the time.

OC was informed that another individual experiencing homelessness who has been in the area for many years is signing a lease and moving into permanent housing today.
