April 22-26

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd and Kanan Rd several times this week.

OC and JT Manwell checked on a vehicle on Canwood that was mistaken as being used as a dwelling. It appears that it is being used as storage and may be abandoned. LHSD have been notified.

OC met with Louis C, Deputy City Manager for updates.

OC was updated by the family of A56 who is dwelling in his vehicle. The family has contacted an organization that does interventions and will attempt to contact IND. OC to follow up.

OC was notified by SDs that C19 was loitering in the bathroom at Sumac Park. OC canvassed the park on Thursday but did not locate IND. IND is known for locking herself in park bathrooms throughout the COG Cities. IND is service resistant.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed Civic Center several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard. C45 was seen at Coffee Bean early in the AM. OC did not engage.

OC sighted C28 at Calabasas Rd. and Parkway Calabasas. IND remains service resistant.

OC checked in with Michael McConville, Deputy City Manager.

OC canvassed Creekside Village several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed The Commons and checked in with Allied Security. C45 has been seen loitering on the property but security was not aware of IND being asked to leave.

OC contacted IND who left a request on the Outreach Portal. OC contacted IND by phone. IND asked if there were service providers in Calabasas. OC explained that the closest locations were in the SFV. OC forwarded a list of providers and suggested IND reach out ASAP.

OC was contacted by phone by an IND seeking information on local service providers. OC suggested several organizations that may be helpful.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow. No contacts.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Legacy Park. Several areas that contained tarps and garbage were spotted. No INDs experiencing homelessness were in those specific areas.

OC counted ten empty shopping carts near the entrance to Legacy Park. If they are still at the location on Wednesday, OC to contact Shopping Cart Services to see if they will return to the appropriate stores.

New Contact: M89, Male, late 40s. IND appears to suffer from mental health issues. IND has been seen in all COG cities. IND was walking on Cross Creek and yelling loudly. OC engaged IND who stated that he was hungry. OC gave IND some cash for something to eat. IND was speaking incoherently. OC informed SD Espinoza.

OC engaged M64 at Starbucks who appears to be decompensating. OC voiced his concern to IND. IND is service resistant. TPC Outreach is aware of the situation and has made several referrals.

OC verified that the ten empty shopping carts have been removed from Legacy Park.

OC engaged M06 who has decided to work with TPC for housing. IND currently obtaining legal documents. IND has been in the area for many years.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd, Agoura Rd, and Lindero Canyon Rd several times this week.

OC canvassed Civic Center and checked in with city staff. No new contacts with individuals experiencing homelessness.

OC canvassed Shoppes at Westlake Village several times this week. No contacts.
