

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

May 6-10

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd, and Kanan Rd. several times this week.

Daily check-in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC and JT Manwell attempted to contact an IND who has an RV parked on Canwood Dr. for approximately two weeks. IND was not at the location. It appears IND has moved on.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons and Courtyard several times this week.

OC canvassed Civic Center several times this week and checked in with city staff.

OC located an IND who was sleeping on the sidewalk at Calabasas Rd and Parkway Calabasas. IND made threats to OC who contacted AGS Security. IND walked toward an unincorporated area at Ventura Blvd and has not been seen since.

OC was notified that there was an altercation between C34 and C45 at the Civic Center. C45 had left the area by the time OC arrived. C34 was asked to leave by the area for the day. OC updated Scott T, Assistant City Manager of individuals' history. Both remain service resistant.

OC received a request from LHSD regarding an IND at Creekside Village with a minor child who was experiencing homelessness. OC located IND and engaged. OC contacted SFVCMHS for assistance with locating a shelter bed. The team forwarded some contact numbers and ultimately, IND was able to locate a bed out of the area. OC provided transport to a Safe Exchange location where shelter staff met IND. OC updated Michael M, Deputy City Manager.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. No recent contacts with INDs experiencing homelessness.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week. An RV has been parked on Valley Circle near the high school for several days. OC did not attempt to engage.

Malibu:

OC was informed that M64 was picked up by DMH and taken to the emergency room. IND is unable to care for himself and will receive the help he needs.

Whole Foods to complete a cart retrieval on Thursday May 9th. OC made the announcement at lunch on Tuesday. Approximately 35 INDs participated at lunch on Tuesday and Thursday.

OC was informed that M40 has been generating calls on Malibu Rd. IND has been in the area for many years and maintains personal relationships with members of the community. IND remains service resistant. OC to follow up.

OC and TPC Outreach canvassed the vacant lot across from Bluffs Park. The area remains vacant and clear of encampments. It was thought that a new individual experiencing homelessness may be camping at the location with her daughter.

An IND experiencing homelessness with her minor child has been located and placed in a hotel.

OC engaged M92 who stated that he is from Malibu and is experiencing homelessness. IND is interested in receiving housing services but has not been on the street continually for one year. IND has returned to the area recently. OC to follow up.

Westlake Village:

OC verified that the IND who was having car troubles at Agoura Rd. and Lindero Canyon Rd. was able to self-resolve the issue over the weekend and is no longer at the location.

OC canvassed Civic Center and checked in with city staff.

OC received a request from LHSD regarding an IND panhandling at Agoura Rd and Lindero Canyon Rd. OC located IND and engaged. IND stated that he was promoting his YouTube Page and was not asking for money. Nothing on the sign indicated that he was panhandling. OC forwarded a list of resources and suggested IND work with a Case Manager. OC updated LHSD.
